

he wanted to feed them. There was quite a number of them to be fed, but a boy had brought five barley loaves and two fish. Five thousand men, along with women and children ate and were satisfied. The duty of any king is to see that his subjects do not go hungry. Kings at the time of Jesus lived in luxury, ate and drank sumptuously, but Jesus, the King ate ordinary food in benefactors' homes, and never indulged in luxurious living.

Jesus is King of Heaven. Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem was like a welcome given to a king. The charges levelled against Jesus by the Jewish authorities before Pilate were also about his kingship. Pilate entered the praetorium and questioned Jesus if he was the king of the Jews. In his answer Jesus clearly stated that his kingship was not of this world. To Pilate's repeated question about His kingship, Jesus finally gave the answer, "You say that I am a king. For this I was born, and for this I have come into the world, to bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears my voice."

As we conclude the liturgical year let us thank the Lord for the marvellous insight we have received through his Word. As we begin yet another liturgical year starting from next Sunday let us ask him to accompany us and to enlighten us.
