

PENTECOST SUNDAY INTRODUCTION TO THE LITURGY OF THE DAY! FIRST READING: Acts 2:1 - 11

On Pentecost, the Holy Spirit was sent to the disciples in the form of fiery. tongues. They began to speak in different tongues, "as the spirit enabled them to proclaim.

SECOND READING: 1 Corinthians 12:3b - 7. 12 - 13

The apostle Paul wrote that there are many gifts but the same Spirit, different ministries but the same Lord.

GOSPEL READING: John 20:19 - 23

Jesus appeared and told the disciples, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you ... Receive the Holy Spirit."

In Acts, the Holy Spirit enables the disciples to speak in tongues, allowing strangers from all over the known world to understand them. •Paul teaches the Corinthians that the Spirit is manifested in a variety of ways, all beneficial, and all united in harmony. In John's gospel, after bestowing the Holy Spirit on the disciples, Jesus tells them that they can forgive sins and they will be forgiven. In each passage, the Holy Spirit transforms the world. Come, Holy Spirit, fill our hearts with your transforming power, enabling us to share your transformative fire with those around us.
