

Amos was a shepherd and a dresser of sycamores when the Lord took thim from following the flock and said to him, "Go, prophesy to my people Israel."

SECOND READING: Ephesians 1:3 - 14

God chose us in Christ to be blameless and full of love. In him we were chosen to "exist for the praise of his glory."

GOSPEL READING: Mark 6:7 - 13

Jesus sent out his disciples two by two to preach the good news. They took nothing with them. In Christ's power they expelled demons and healed the sick.

From Amos to the twelve apostles, God calls people of faith to serve others. Amos, a shepherd and horticulturist, was called to prophesy to Israel instead. St. Paul was called to bring Christ's message to Gentiles all around the world. The Twelve were sent by Jesus in pairs to heal the sick and drive out demons. As we listen to today's readings, let us consider how we are called by God to give witness to the gospel.

He instructed them to take nothing for the journey but a walking stick—no food, no sack, no money in their belts. Mark 6:8


Does God care about the smallest details in your life? Does He care about you receiving proper food and housing? Does He care about your proper emotional, material and spiritual support? He certainly does!
