#### **Sacrament of Baptism**

Fourth Sunday of each month. Please register your children at the Church Office. Present a copy of the child(ren) birth certificate(s). A minimum of 4 classes is required.

#### **Confraternity of Christian Doctrine (CCD) Classes**

Classes are held every Saturday during the school year and begin with attendance and instruction in the lower level of Columban Hall at 9:00 a.m.

## Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes

RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. #### My Dear Parishioners,

Today, the eighth Sunday of ordinary time, the church continues to remind us of the virtues and qualities that should characterize our lives as Christians. Our mother Church reminds us that while physical appearance could be deceptive, what determines who we are is what comes from within us. This includes the quality of our words, the wisdom, and the goodness that we manifest. The first reading is a call to be very careful in evaluating people based on their appearances rather than on the wisdom that comes from them. It says: "The test of a man is in his conversation. A man's word betrays what! he feels. Do not praise him before he speaks." Despite this, it suffices to note that one needs a lot of wisdom to discern the truth in someone's word. This is true, especially given that many people say beautiful words to please and deceive others while their hearts are far from the truth. Christ says: These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me" (Mt 15:8). In today's gospel, Jesus also teaches us that the quality of our heart determines the quality of our words and actions. He says, "A good person, out of the store of goodness in his heart produces good, while an evil person, out of a store of evil produces evil; for from the fullness of the heart the mouth speaks." So, today we must ask ourselves, do my words edify or make any positive difference on others? Does it build or destroy the community? Additionally, Christ warns us today to be careful in judging others. Instead, we should be humble enough to look inwards before criticizing others. Hence, Paul reminds us: "If you think you are standing strong, be careful not to fall" (ICorlO:12).
