

I. Dear Brethren, our Holy Week schedule is as follows:

PALM SUNDAY (APRIL 01/02): All Masses will begin with a procession from the Shrine, 15 minutes prior to the usual time, that is: 5:45pm on Saturday, 7:15am, 9:45am and 4:45pm on Sunday. Please, make sure to have a Palm. Those who usually park their cars along the paved road going up front of the Church will need to look for an appropriate space elsewhere, for all masses.

CHRISM MASS: The Traditional Chrism mass during which all Priests renew their Sacerdotal Promises around the Bishop, and the Oils are blessed for the administration of Sacraments is scheduled for Tuesday April 04, 2023 at 11:00AM Saint Peter and Paul Cathedral. We are highly encouraged to attend and participate. Kind reminder: it is the usual occasion to support the Bishop to take care of the priests in his diocese. Our generosity will be greatly appreciated.

HOLY THURSDAY: Mass will begin at 7:00PM. It is the day of **the Institutions of both the Ministry of Priesthood and the Sacrament of the Eucharist**, the day the very first mass took place in human history. We shall celebrate these events in the spirit of Charity and Service, with the **Washing of the Feet** of some members of our community. Following the mass, will be adoration of the Blessed Sacrament till 10:00PM in this order:

From 8:30PM to 09:00PM: Readers, Altar Servers, Saint Joseph Workers, CCD Students and Formators

From 09:00PM to 09:30PM: Legion of Mary, Ushers, Money Counters, Social Committee, Youth group, Church Cleaners, Children of Mary

From 09:30PM to 10:00PM: Saint Vincent de Paul, Charismatic Renewal, Music Ministry and Choirs and Sacristans.

All Parishioners are free to join any of these shifts for adoration.
