# WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Isaiah 55:6-9 Responsorial Psalm: Ps 145:2-3, 8-9, 17-18 Second Reading: Philippians 1:20c-24, 27a Gospel: Luke 8:4-15

#### Entry into God's gratuity is a gift of His love!

Beloved Brothers and Sisters,

On this 25th Sunday of Ordinary Time, Year A, the Lord invites us to enter into the gratuitousness of his love.

In our today's Gospel text, the first comers have put themselves in a privileged position in relation to the last comers. But that's not what matters to Jesus. God's grace is freely given and freely received. Arguing with the Master of the vineyard about the wages given to the last comers puts the workers of the sixth hour in a position of pride that prevents them from receiving God's gift with joy and thanksgiving. They are arrogant and lacking in brotherly love. Lacking love for our brothers and sisters, whatever their social rank, places us in a position of inferiority in the Kingdom of God.

This parable is a good illustration of the kind of relationship the Lord is building with us. He invites all those who allow themselves to be met into his work. He never tires of rewarding those who set to work, regardless of age, condition or background. What counts is the present and the future.

With each and every one of us, according to who we are and what we can and know how to do, God is writing a unique and incomparable story. It's incredible, incomprehensible, and that's what bothers us.

If we read today's gospel in human terms, we risk calling God unjust. The Good News of this parable is this: *God doesn't calculate. I don't deserve heaven*; *it's given to me freely.* This is the boldness we are invited to believe in, not only for ourselves, but also for our neighbor. May the Good News of this parable flood us with such joy that we can do nothing but give thanks for God's gift to us.

# Entering into God's gratuitousness is a gift of his love for our shrunken hearts!

We risk reintroducing the rules of human work into the Kingdom, even though it is a gift from God. We ask him to order our work more in the perspective of the Kingdom of God. It's such a great joy to work on God's work!

This is how **the last will be first and the first last**. The good "thief" on the Cross is "today," i.e. before all others, in the Kingdom with Jesus.

#### **Sacrament of Infant Baptism**

Fourth Sunday of each month. Please register your children at the Church Office. Present a copy of the child(ren)'s birth certificate(s). A minimum of 2 classes is required, on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Fridays of each month.

#### **Confraternity of Christian Doctrine (CCD) Classes**

Classes are held every Saturday during the school year and begin with attendance and instruction in the lower level of Columban Hall at 9:00 a.m.

#### **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes**

RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion.
