WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Job 7:1-4, 6-7

Responsorial Psalm: Psalms 147:1-2, 3-4, 5-6 **Second Reading:** 1 Corinthians 9:16-19, 22-23

Gospel: Mark 1:29-39

Reflection by Rev. Fr. Isaac Agbenohevi

Theme: "Jesus Christ: Our True Healing and Satisfaction"

Job, in the first reading of today, laments bitterly describing the human reality and condition as an experience of utter hopelessness - an experience of servitude, futility and humiliation. The lamentation of Job was his response to the sudden disaster which befell him despite his innocence and faithfulness to God. He felt that his strange sickness (illness) will eventually lead to his death. In great pain and distress, he remarked, "Remember that my life is like the wind; I shall not see happiness again." Many unpleasant experiences in life, such as sickness, death, natural disasters etc., put us through difficulties and, sometimes, lead us to situations of hopelessness. In spite of his great suffering and frustration which compelled him to express his humiliating and hopeless situation, Job continued to have confidence in the Lord and he was sure that the Lord will deliver him (see Job 19:25-27).

The episode, in the gospel of today, presents Jesus as healing many different people who were having different physical and spiritual health challenges – such as fever, demonic possession etc. In fact, Mark gives a graphic description of the context and situation:

"When it was evening, after sunset,
they brought to him all who were ill or possessed by demons.
The whole town was gathered at the door.
He cured many who were sick with various diseases,
and he drove out many demons,
not permitting them to speak because they knew him." (see Mark 1:32-34)

The reality and content of the kingdom of God which is inaugurated in the person of Jesus Christ and proclaimed by him is unpacked through his public ministry. Jesus' ministry of healing and exorcism (and other miracles and activities) were practical demonstrations of the power of the kingdom of God and its arrival. In this ministry, Jesus defeats and overcomes the devil (evil) who is the greatest threat to the presence of God which is in our midst in the person of Jesus Christ. It is in Jesus Christ that we find true healing, renewal, and satisfaction. Just as he responded positively to the spiritual and physical needs of those whose different situations and conditions were brought to his attention (Simon Peter's mother in-law and the many sick people), so he takes the first step and comes to us in various ways daily - through his word, the Eucharist, devotional practices, the people around us etc. It is important for us to know that life without Jesus Christ is empty, dry and full of crises. The various situations of emptiness, dryness and crisis are fertile opportunities for the devil to harm us spiritually and physically. Jesus, however, is able to change our situation and story. Let us, therefore, seize the opportunity of the various occasions that Jesus makes himself present to us to present our needs to him confident of receiving true healing, satisfaction, guidance and renewal from him.

God of Mercy and Compassion,

We thank you for your daily presence in our Lives!

You sent your Son to our world to inaugurate your kingdom and defeat the power of evil and sin. In his ministry, he healed the sick, exorcized the demon-possessed and brought rest, comfort and renewal to those who were in various unpleasant conditions and situations. Help us to also experience your healing, comfort and renewal through our daily encounter with you in your word and sacraments. We make our prayer through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Catechesis

THE HOLY EUCHARIST Source And Summit of the Christian and Ecclesial Life

The holy Eucharist completes Christian initiation. Those who have been raised to the dignity of the royal priesthood by Baptism and configured more deeply to Christ by Confirmation participate with the whole community in the Lord's own sacrifice by means of the Eucharist. "At the Last Supper, on the night he was betrayed, our Savior instituted the Eucharistic sacrifice of his Body and Blood. This he did in order to perpetuate the sacrifice of the cross throughout the ages until he should come again, and so to entrust to his beloved Spouse, the Church, a memorial of his death and resurrection: a sacrament of love, a sign of unity, a bond of charity, a Paschal banquet 'in which Christ is consumed, the mind is filled with grace, and a pledge of future glory is given to us."135

The Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life." ¹³⁶ "The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself, our Pasch." ¹³⁷ "The Eucharist is the efficacious sign and sublime cause of that communion in the divine life and that unity of the People of God by which the Church is kept in being. It is the culmination both of God's action sanctifying the world in Christ and of the worship men offer to Christ and through him to the Father in the Holy Spirit." ¹³⁸

Finally, by the Eucharistic celebration we already unite ourselves with the heavenly liturgy and anticipate eternal life, when God will be all in all.¹³⁹ In brief, the Eucharist is the sum and summary of our faith: "Our way of thinking is attuned to the Eucharist, and the Eucharist in turn confirms our way of thinking."¹⁴⁰




