

WEEKLY REFLECTION

Procession Gospel: Mark 11:1-10 **First Reading:** Isaiah 50:4-7

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 22:8-9, 17-18, 19-20, 23-24

Second Reading: Philippians 2:6-11

Gospel: Mark 14:1—15:47

Theme: "Jesus Christ - Our Strength and Salvation"

The Liturgical celebration of Palm or Passion Sunday marks the beginning of the Holy Week, the most important week on the Liturgical Calendar. In this week, we celebrate, in a particular manner, the fundamental mysteries of our Christian Faith – the paschal mystery (the passion, death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ). Today, Jesus triumphantly enters Jerusalem, the city of his destiny, to accomplish the Paschal mystery. There he will be betrayed, arrested, handed over to evil doers, maltreated and abused, crucified, died but he will rise again on the Third Day. His victory supersedes everything else he will suffer. In view of this, Jesus enters the Holy City as someone who is victorious signifying his victory over sin, evil and earth. He goes to Jerusalem as the true High Priest and King who takes away the sins of the world. As he enters the Sanctuary (Temple), he offers the once and for all sacrifice for the salvation of the world and sinful humanity. Let us avail ourselves of this opportunity offering ourselves to him so that he would present his worthy sacrifice, including ourselves, to God our Father.

Prayer:

Lord Jesus Christ,

through your cross and resurrection, you have redeemed the world and set us free from the ravages of sin and death. Help us to see in your passion and death our own death so that, imitating you, we will also have a share in your resurrection. Amen!!

Sacrament of Infant Baptism

Catechesis

What is Holy Week?

Holy Week is an important time for Christians throughout the world. Holy Week, the final week of Lent, begins on Palm Sunday, the Sunday before Easter. Holy Week is a time when Catholics gather to remember and participate in the Passion of Jesus Christ. The Passion was the final period of Christ's life in Jerusalem. It spans from when He arrived in Jerusalem to when He was crucified.

How Do Catholics Celebrate Holy Week?

Four special ceremonies commemorate the events of Christ's Passion from His entrance into Jerusalem, when palm branches were placed in His path, through His arrest on Holy Thursday and Crucifixion on Good Friday, to Holy Saturday, the day that Christ's body lay in the tomb.

The summit of the Liturgical Year is the Easter Triduum—from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season, and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil.

The liturgical services that take place during the **Triduum** are:

- Mass of the Lord's Supper
- Good Friday of the Lord's Passion
- Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord

What Are the Noticeable Changes in the Church During Holy Week?

On Good Friday and Holy Saturday, noticeable changes take place in the way churches are decorated. Many churches, especially in Europe, statues and cross are covered in purple or black cloth, or simply remove the decor. Holy water is removed from the church and Holy Saturday and church bells remain silent until the Gloria at Easter Vigil.




