WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Exodus 20:1-17

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 19:8, 9, 10, 11;

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 1:22-25

Gospel: John 2:13-25

Reflection by Rev. Fr. Isaac Agbenohevi

Theme: "Zeal for the things of God"

The episode of the Cleansing of the Temple by Jesus, in the Gospel of John, is placed in the context of the Jewish Pilgrimage Festival of Passover when all Jews in the world do a pilgrimage to the Holy Land and the Holy City, Jerusalem. The presence of Jesus in Jerusalem was very opportune since it occasions his dramatic and spectacular act of cleansing the Temple (a sign) of the filth, inappropriate religious and economic practices and desecration by its patrons. Jesus reminds them of the true and right purpose of the Temple as a House of Prayer for all people. The right use of the Temple involves not only the right performance of the right religious and cultic practices (burnt offerings, prayers, proclamation of the word of God) there, but also keeping it from every form of stain and impurity. In the season of Lent, we are challenged to re-examine our ways especially the appropriate and responsible use of our body since it is the Temple of God (of the Holy Spirit). Our body as Temple of the Holy Spirit implies that it should be kept decent, clean, pleasant and holy for the Lord. Thus, we need to live according to the demands of God's word. This is true righteousness and justice, and that is what the first reading from the book of Exodus invites us to reflect on. In the Decalogue (the Ten Commandments), we are invited to be zealous for the things of God by listening to God's word and living it daily. Let us pray for the grace to be true "zealots" of the things of God and be true witnesses of the good things of the Lord by living according to the demands of his commands.

Praver:

Almighty and Compassionate God,

You offer us the season of Lent as a providential time to return to you, our Father.

Grant that our observances of prayer, fasting and almsgiving will enable us to be zealous in keeping your commands and in keeping our bodies worthy for the celebration of your victory in Christ at the Paschal

Sacrament of Infant Baptism

Confraternity of Christian Doctrine (CCD) Classes

Catechesis

What is the meaning of Lent?

Lent is a 40 day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. It is a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter. During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully. We recall the waters of baptism in which we were also baptized into Christ's death, died to sin and evil, and began new life in Christ.

Many know of the tradition of abstaining from meat on Fridays during Lent, but we are also called to practice self-discipline and fast in other ways throughout the season. In addition, the giving of alms is one way to share God's gifts—not only through the distribution of money, but through the sharing of our time and talents. As St. John Chrysostom reminds us: "Not to enable the poor to share in our goods is to steal from them and deprive them of life. The goods we possess are not ours, but theirs." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 2446).

In Lent, the baptized are called to renew their baptismal commitment as others prepare to be baptized through the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, a period of learning and discernment for individuals who have declared their desire to become Catholics.




