WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Acts 4:32-35 **Responsorial Psalm**: Psalm 118:2-4.13-15.22-24 **Second Reading**: 1 John 5:1-6 **Gospel**: John 20:19-31

Theme: "The Mercy of God – Our Place of Refuge" The Second Sunday of Easter is traditionally considered as the Divine Mercy Sunday. It celebrates the unconditional and immeasurable mercy and compassion of God which spring from his love for humanity. The entire paschal mystery, which we celebrate at Easter, is triggered by God's love, mercy and compassion. It is, in this context, that we discover our true selves, our identity and our mission as Christians. The Easter mystery challenges to live a new life in the light of God – the life of the resurrection. This new life is inspired by and lived in Jesus Christ, the author and perfecto of our Faith. It is in living a life of love, mercy, and compassion that we truly live as the people of the resurrection. The Risen Lord, in the gospel, does not only empower the apostles to forgive sins, but also, by extension, challenges all of us to forgive those who have offended us and love one another. Let us ask the Lord for the grace of forgiveness confident of living a life of mercy, compassion and love. It is in the mercy of God that we find refuge and security in the different scenes of life.

Sacrament of Infant Baptism:

Infant Baptism will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month. A minimum of two (2) classes are required. Please register your child, a copy of their birth certificates is also required.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes:

RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. Catechesis

What Is Divine Mercy?

Divine Mercy has been called "the greatest grassroots movement in the history of the Catholic Church" and has changed millions of lives. But what is it? Divine Mercy gets to the heart of Sacred Scripture. In fact, as the Catechism of the Catholic Church says, "The Gospel is the revelation in Jesus Christ of God's mercy to sinners" (1849). Right there: That summarizes it. Divine Mercy is the Gospel. It's the good news. And so, it gets to the very center of our faith. Moreover, in the words of Pope Benedict XVI, "Divine Mercy is not a secondary devotion, but an integral dimension of Christian faith and prayer." Benedict even goes so far as to say, "Mercy is the central nucleus of the Gospel message."

So, what is Divine Mercy? What is this thing that gets to the heart of Sacred Scripture and to the very center of our faith? To begin, mercy is "love's second name," as John Paul II said. It's a particular kind of love, a particular mode of love when it encounters suffering, poverty, brokenness, and sin. Divine Mercy is when God's love meets us and helps us in the midst of our suffering and sin. In fact, because this side of eternity we're all sinners and because suffering is our lot in life, God's love for us here always takes the form of mercy. It's always the Lord stepping out in compassion to help us poor, weak, and broken sinners. From our perspective, then, every good we receive is an expression Divine Mercy.

Why the Message of Divine Mercy?

The message of Divine Mercy is something that's most associated with a Polish nun who died in 1938, about a year before the start of World War II. She's known today as St. Maria Faustina Kowalska. Saint Faustina was a mystic. In other words, she received extraordinary experiences of the Lord Jesus in prayer. In fact, Jesus appeared to her and even spoke with her. Of course, Jesus didn't reveal some new Gospel when he appeared to St. Faustina. He already revealed everything He needed to say 2,000 years ago to the Apostles and through Sacred Scripture. So, why did He do it? Why did He appear to Faustina? Actually, why does He appear to any mystic for that matter? God sometimes appears to mystics because He has a prophetic message for a particular time in history, and He uses particular men and women to share His message. Sometimes it's to remind us of something that's been forgotten. Sometimes it's a warning. At other times, it's a message of comfort. Or it may simply be a call to conversion. Whatever it is, it doesn't change the Bible. Rather, it brings us back to it at a certain time in history.
