WEEKLY REFLECTION

Reflection by Rev. Fr. Isaac Agbenohevi

Theme: **“We are the Easter people and Alleluia is our Song”**

Today, together with the entire universal Church, we celebrate the greatest event of the Christian Religion (Faith) – the Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ. It is the fundamental mystery of our Faith. We are Christians because of the Resurrection of Jesus. In his resurrection, Jesus brings to completion and perfection his accomplishment of the Paschal Mystery (his passion, death and resurrection). Jesus has renewed all things and has reconciled the whole of creation to God, the Father. The exhortation of St. Augustine, “We are the Easter people and Alleluia is our song”, should set our hearts on fire and inspire us to live an “easter” life – thus, living in the light of God and abandoning the works of darkness. We must decide to live a life demonstrating our complete faith in God – a life of love, mercy, compassion, trust and community. Easter also means creating a better life and world for one another and eschewing all forms of evil and sinful tendencies. Let us rejoice as community of Faith on this day and resolve to live as people of the Resurrection.

Prayer: Lord Jesus Christ, In your resurrection, you overcame death and sin and demonstrated your victory as the Risen one. Help us to die to ourselves daily so that we will always live as children of the resurrection. Amen!!

Catechesis

WHAT IS EASTER?

Easter is a Christian religious holiday, also known as a feast day, that celebrates the Resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, as described in the New Testament of the Bible. It is considered the most important and oldest festival of the Christian Church. Easter is preceded by the season of Lent, a 40-day period of fasting, prayer, and penance. The exact date of Easter varies each year because it is based on the lunar calendar. It generally falls on the first Sunday after the first full moon following the vernal equinox, which is around March 21. As a result, Easter can occur between March 22 and April 25. In addition to its religious significance, Easter has also become associated with various secular traditions and customs. These include the Easter bunny, egg decorating, egg hunts, and the giving of Easter baskets filled with candy and gifts. These traditions are often observed by people of various religious and cultural backgrounds, making Easter a widely celebrated and recognized holiday in many parts of the world. Easter commemorates the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the tomb, occurring three days after His crucifixion. It fulfills the prophecy of the Messiah's persecution, death for our sins, and resurrection, as foretold in Isaiah 53. This event serves as a reminder of our victory over sin and a source of daily hope. According to the New Testament, Easter falls three days after Jesus' crucifixion, following a period of fasting known as Lent, which begins on Ash Wednesday and concludes on Good Friday, the day of Jesus' death. Pope Gregory I established the 40-day duration of Lent, drawing inspiration from the biblical accounts of Israel, Moses, Elijah, and Jesus' time in the wilderness. After Christians spend time in reflection during the 40 days of Lent, we remember the event that shook the whole world. That our Lord conquered death. The Old Testament prophesied about this event hundreds of times, hundreds to thousands of years prior to the Resurrection. It's not just a big deal. It's the biggest deal in all of Christianity. The Easter story, as recounted in all four Gospels of the New Testament, begins with the crucifixion of Jesus Christ, His burial, and culminates in His resurrection from the dead. In Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John, Jesus is crucified by the Roman authorities at the instigation of religious leaders. He is then buried in a tomb belonging to Joseph of Arimathea. On the third day after His death, women visit the tomb and find it empty, with angels announcing Jesus' resurrection. They encounter Jesus alive, who then appears to His disciples, providing them with evidence of His resurrection before ascending into heaven. This miraculous event confirms Jesus' identity as the Son of God and the fulfillment of prophecies regarding the Messiah. For many, Easter is also a time to reflect on the meaning of life and the power of love and forgiveness.

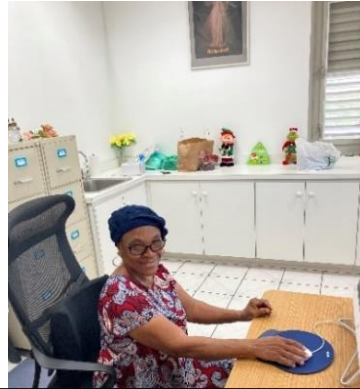

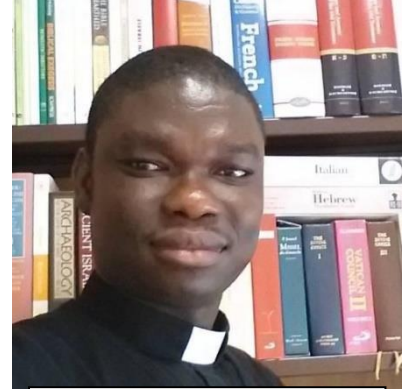

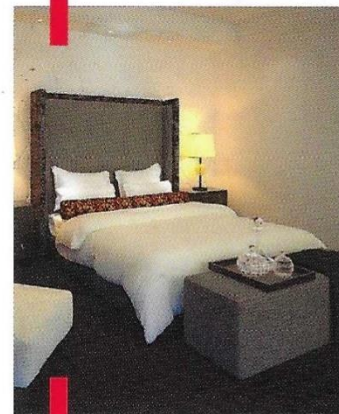
