Reflection by Rev. Fr. Isaac Agbenohevi

Theme: "God is impartial by nature and in his ways" The true vine is the reason for the existence of humanity – it is in him that the entire human experience and reality has meaning and value. Each branch necessarily needs him for both its existence and functioning. Jesus Christ, the Son of God, is open to all who are engrafted onto him who is the true vine. He is impartial and just in his ways. This is the focus of the readings of today. God does not discriminate against anyone, but he is gracious and faithful to all. This explains the remark of Peter, in the first reading, that "...God shows no partiality, but in every nation anyone who fears him and does what is right is acceptable to him" (see Acts 10:34-35). Those who fear him and live according to the demands of his will are blessed by him. We are challenged to be attached and joined to Jesus who is always ready to bless any of us no matter our situation (both spiritual and physical).

Catechesis

WHAT IS HOLINESS?

Holiness is a word that can make us feel uneasy. It seems lofty, threatening, alien. We instinctively sense that God's holiness has dangerous overtones. His purity calls our sinful attachments into question, demanding that we forsake them in order to enjoy the greatest of all goods—belonging to a God of infinite love and power. To come casually with our hearts grasping tightly to the sins we cherish or to come lightly as though they are no big deal, might be like throwing ourselves onto a roaring fire with the expectation we will not perish. How, then, can wesinful and broken human beings—hope to come into the presence of a holy God and survive the experience? When God was forging a relationship with the Israelites, he told Moses to "Give the following instructions to the entire community of Israel. You must be holy because I, the LORD your God, am holy" (see Leviticus 19:2). God was calling his people into relationship with himself, and he wanted his people not only to survive the experience but to be nourished by it. But for that to happen, they needed to know the ground rules, needed to come to him on his terms not theirs. The Hebrew word for "holiness" is godes, a word that highlights the realm of the sacred in contrast to everything common and profane. The adjective qādôš, "holy," refers to God and what belongs to him. In various places in the Hebrew Scriptures, God is called by the title the "Holy One of Israel."

WHAT CAN BE HOLY?

Time, space, objects, and people—all can become holy if they belong to God. The temple in Jerusalem was considered holy space, and the objects used in worship holy objects. The Sabbaths and feasts of Israel were considered holy days or seasons. And the Israelites were called God's holy people by virtue of belonging to him (to be continued).

Bible Reading Guide

The Steps of Lectio Divina

- Choose a text of the Scriptures that you wish to pray.
- Place yourself in a quiet environment. Calm your anxieties and thoughts, and acknowledge God's presence.
- Offer a prayer to the Holy Spirit for inspiration and guidance: Come, Holy Spirit, enlighten my heart and mind to listen to your Word.
- 1. Lectio: Read the text slowly and prayerfully, constantly listening for that word that God has prepared for you. You may want to re-read the same text multiple times to help quiet yourself interiorly and focus on God's voice. Listen and receive the Word that God speaks to you.
- 2. *Meditatio*: When a word or phrase strikes you, stop and rest with it. Repeat the word or phrase to yourself. Allow it to speak to you in a personal way by pondering the word in your heart, reflecting on what it means to you. Memorize it and repeat it to yourself, allowing it to interact with your thoughts, hopes, memories, and desires.
- 3. Oratio: Prayer is your response to God's word. It begins your dialogue with God that comes from your heart. Formulate a prayer, as a response to God. What do you want to say to the Lord in response to the Word spoken to you? Enter into this loving conversation with God.
- 4. Contemplatio: Rest in God's presence and receive His transforming embrace. Sit still with God, realizing that in this deep and profound relationship, words are not necessary. Be content and at peace with a wordless, quiet rest in God, which brings joy to the heart. Remember that contemplation is not *your* action or doing, rather it is allowing God to act in you.
