WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Exodus 24:3-8

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 116:12-13, 15-16, 17-18

Second Reading: Hebrews 9:11-15

Gospel: Mark 14:12-16, 22-26

Reflection by Rev. Fr. Isaac Agbenohevi

Theme: “The Holy Eucharist – Our Life and Salvation”

The solemnity of Corpus Christi celebrates the wondrous mystery of the real presence of Jesus Christ – in his Body and Blood – in the Eucharistic sacrament. The Gospel of Mark presents a very graphic description of the institution of the Eucharistic mystery in the Upper Room, a day before Jesus’ crucifixion and death. In the words, “Take it; this is my body” and “This is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many,” the author explains the mystery of the Body and Blood of Jesus as a sacramental reality which effects an everlasting covenant inuring to the forgiveness of sins and the salvation of many people. In the sacrament of the Body and Blood of Jesus, we have the real presence of God with us always – this is our life and our salvation. On this day, we are invited not only to receive often this most blessed sacrament but also to receive it worthily (in the state of grace). The reception of Jesus, in his body and blood, should be a source of life and salvation and not a means of our condemnation. Let us pray for the grace to acknowledge and confess the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharistic reality and live this mystery in the concrete situations of our life.

Prayer:

Lord Jesus Christ,

In the sacrament of your body and blood, you have left us a memorial of your passion, grant that our reception and adoration of this most blessed and mysterious sacrament would bring us true fulfilment and satisfaction in this life and eternal life with you in heaven.

Catechesis

What is Corpus Christi?

The words Corpus Christi literally mean “body of Christ” in Latin. Corpus Christi, also called the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, is a religious festival celebrated by many Roman Catholics on the first Thursday after Trinity Sunday, which is the first Sunday after Pentecost. In some countries it is celebrated on the next Sunday after Trinity Sunday. This means that Corpus Christi is celebrated roughly two months after Easter. For those who believe in transubstantiation, the feast is to celebrate the real presence of the body of Christ (the corpus Christi) in the bread and wine of the Eucharist. In some countries with a predominantly Catholic population, the Feast of Corpus Christi is also celebrated outside the church with parades, where the Host is carried through the streets.

The feast or festival called Corpus Christi originated in 1246 and was first celebrated in the diocese of Robert de Torote, bishop of Liège, Belgium. Jacques Pantaléon, who had been archdeacon of Liège, became Pope Urban IV, and in 1264 he ordered the whole church to observe the feast. By the mid-14th century, the festival was generally accepted, and in the 15th century, it became one of the principal feasts of the Roman Catholic Church.

Of course, such veneration of the bread and wine of the Eucharist is rejected by evangelicals. Jesus said, “Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise them up at the last day” (John 6:24). However, Jesus was not speaking literally, as He explains a little later: “I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty” (John 6:34). Eating and drinking Jesus’ body and blood are not done literally, but by “coming” and “believing.” **(Source: Catholic Resources – Biblical Answers)**

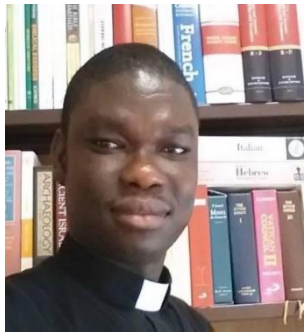

Bible Reading Guide

The Steps of Lectio Divina

- Choose a text of the Scriptures that you wish to pray.
- Place yourself in a quiet environment. Calm your anxieties and thoughts, and acknowledge God's presence.
- Offer a prayer to the Holy Spirit for inspiration and guidance: *Come, Holy Spirit, enlighten my heart and mind to listen to your Word.*

1. **Lectio:** Read the text slowly and prayerfully, constantly listening for that word that God has prepared for you. You may want to re-read the same text multiple times to help quiet yourself interiorly and focus on God's voice. Listen and receive the Word that God speaks to you.

2. **Meditatio:** When a word or phrase strikes you, stop and rest with it. Repeat the word or phrase to yourself. Allow it to speak to you in a personal way by pondering the word in your heart, reflecting on what it means to you. Memorize it and repeat it to yourself, allowing it to interact with your thoughts, hopes, memories, and desires.

3. **Oratio:** Prayer is your response to God's word. It begins your dialogue with God that comes from your heart. Formulate a prayer, as a response to God. *What do you want to say to the Lord in response to the Word spoken to you?* Enter into this loving conversation with God.

4. **Contemplatio:** Rest in God's presence and receive His transforming embrace. Sit still with God, realizing that in this deep and profound relationship, words are not necessary. Be content and at peace with a wordless, quiet rest in God, which brings joy to the heart. Remember that contemplation is not *your* action or doing, rather it is allowing God to act in you.

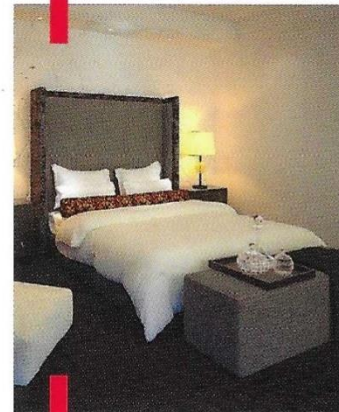
