

WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Wisdom 1:13-15; 2:23-24

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 30:2, 4, 5-6, 11, 12, 13

Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 8:7, 9, 13-15

Gospel: Mark 5:21-43

Reflection by Rev. Fr. Modeste Digwou

"Fear not, only believe!"

Today, as was the case with Jairus, the synagogue ruler in this 13th Sunday's Gospel, the Lord Jesus says to each one of us: "**Do not fear, only believe.**" He invites us to open up to him with all our heart, to have complete faith and trust in him.

In fact, today's Gospel tells us two stories of healing, with strong similarities: on the one hand, the hemorrhoidal woman, suffering from blood loss for twelve years; on the other, a twelve-year-old girl at death's door. In both cases, it's life that's at stake: the hemorrhoidal woman can't give birth because of the continuous loss of blood; the young girl is at the point of losing her own life, having just reached the age where she can procreate. And in both cases, everything happens through touch: the woman seeks to touch Jesus; and Jesus takes hold of the hand of Jairus' daughter.

Often, we realize that all this searching does not fulfill this desire; for our true life finds its fulfillment in our attachment to the Lord alone, who can make us sources of life in abundance: indeed, as today's second reading reminds us, it is from the "generous gift of our Lord Jesus Christ" that we receive life.

Remember: the encounter with the Lord unfolds for each of us in a personal and particular way. Like the woman with hemorrhoids, let's learn to draw near to the Lord, to touch him and let ourselves be touched by him, revealing to him, in all truth, all our pain, to hear from him this beautiful announcement: "Your faith has saved you, go in peace and be healed of your pain." Let's imagine that this woman had not revealed herself to the Lord (out of shame at her impurity or fear of "what people will say"), she would not have heard this word of liberation from the Lord.

Likewise, if Jairus, the synagogue ruler, had allowed himself to be brought down by the news of his daughter's certain death, or by the mockery of those for whom all was lost for this child, he would not have witnessed Jesus' beautiful gesture of taking the child's hand and awakening her from death to life, enabling her to walk again, that is, to move forward in life and be active. Like her, if we know how to entrust ourselves to the Lord, beyond all adversity and mockery, the Lord - who does not rejoice to see us die (as the first reading reminds us) - will know how to take us by the hand to enable us to walk again on the path of life.

So let us open our lives and our hearts to the Lord's saving action; let us entrust ourselves totally to him in faith, so that he can touch us and give our lives a new flavor.

AMEN.

Catechesis

What does "Thy will be done" mean?

As we pray the Lord's Prayer at each Mass, a mysterious formula comes to mind: "Thy will be done on Earth as it is in Heaven"? But what is this will?

"Thy will be done on Earth as it is in Heaven." It may sound simple, but this formula has many levels of meaning. The Catechism of the Catholic Church sheds light on what God's will is in its section on the Our Father. This will is that of a father who loves his children, and wishes them the best. In this case, the best that can happen to us is the salvation of our souls.

The Catechism emphasizes that "it is our Father's Will that all men should be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth" (cf. 1 Tim 2:4). He "is patient, not wanting anyone to perish" (2 Pet 3:9). "His commandment, which sums up all the others, and tells us all his will, is that we love one another, as he has loved us (cf. Jn 13:34)." (CCC 2822)

God is love, and he doesn't want any of his children to perish. He wants to gather all into his fold. "He has made known to us the mystery of his will, in Jesus, we have been set apart, according to the preordained plan of the One who conducts all things according to his will." (Eph 1:9-11). We urge the full realization of this benevolent purpose, on earth as it is already in heaven." (CCC 2823)

Jesus accomplishes the Father's will.


In order to accomplish the Father's will on earth as in heaven, Jesus came and gave his life for all: "In Christ and through his human will, the Father's will was perfectly accomplished once and for all. Jesus said on entering this world: "Behold, I come to do, O God, Thy will" (Heb 10:7; Ps 40:7). Only Jesus can say: "I always do what pleases Him" (Jn 8:29). In the prayer of his agony, he consented totally to this will: "Not my will, but thine be done" (Lk 22:42). It is for this reason that Jesus "gave himself up for our sins, in order to deliver us from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father." And 'it is in virtue of this will that we are sanctified by the oblation of the Body of Jesus Christ' (Heb 10:10)." (CCC 2824)

By praying the Our Father, we seek to align our will with God's, allowing ourselves to be loved by Him, now and for eternity.


