# TWENTY-FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME SEPTEMBER 22, 2024

### WEEKLY REFLECTION

**First Reading:** Wisdom 2:12, 17-20 **Responsorial Psalm:** Psalm 54:3-4, 5, 6 & 8 **Second Reading:** James 3:16–4:3 **Gospel:** Mark 9:30-37

Reflection by Rev. Fr. Modeste Digwou

Theme: On the roads of Galilee..... "What were you discussing on the way?"

This week's Word of God takes us back to one of the highlights of Jesus' life with his disciples. In this morning's Gospel, Saint Mark takes us into Jesus' conversations as he travels through Galilee. There are three topics that the evangelist chooses to help the first communities get to know Jesus better and follow him. But also three beautiful considerations to inspire us this week.

#### "The Son of Man is to be betrayed and they will kill him."

Last Sunday, Jesus announced his passion and death for the first time, and this did not leave the Apostle Peter indifferent, for he could not hear with his own ears that this was happening to the Master. By announcing for the second time his death on the cross and the sufferings that will accompany it, Jesus draws his disciples into the mystery of God's love, who sent him to bear the sins of the world and reconcile mankind to Himself. After this second announcement of his passion, his disciples are afraid to question him, as if this revelation of the coming passion were for them an impossible secret to bear, as if the sufferings to come were already casting their shadow, the shadow of failure, over their daily life with Jesus. Yet Jesus is content to confirm to the disciples that this is indeed the destiny towards which he is heading. He will give them more details when the time comes.

#### "What were you discussing on the way?"

This is the second subject of today's Gospel from Saint Mark. The disciples had been discussing among themselves who was the greatest, as if to say that if the Master is no longer here, who will take his place? Their preoccupations and conversations thus appear to be entirely in the spirit of the world, the "worldly" spirit: *"If anyone wants to be first, let him be last of all and servant of all."* The disciples remain silent, embarrassed, for they had turned their backs on Jesus' passion. As if to forget the path of suffering, they had made plans for greatness and had begun to compare themselves. Jesus responds with true greatness, which is to make himself the last of all, to place himself below all, not to make a show of showy humility, but by putting himself in a position to serve all his brothers and sisters.

In the second reading, the Letter of Saint James denounces this worldly mentality: "Where do wars come from, where do conflicts among you come from? Is it not precisely from all these desires that are fighting within yourselves? You are covetous and you get nothing, so you kill; you are jealous and you don't get what you want, so you fight and make war." Jesus invites us to put ourselves in the school of a tiny child:

# *"Whoever welcomes a child like this in my name, welcomes me. And he who welcomes me does not welcome me, but the One who sent me."*

This is the third consideration. When we stop worrying about being the greatest, we open ourselves up to welcoming and serving others. Welcoming a brother in the name of Jesus means making room for him in our lives, by referring to the person of Jesus and his work, to what Jesus is for this brother. In Jesus' mind, the child is a living parable: we welcome him without looking to see if he deserves it, even before he can deserve it, simply because he needs to be welcomed. This is the welcome Jesus asks of us for the smallest, most insignificant of the brothers he sends our way. In the Christian community, the values of personal advancement, competition and success are not what is sought first and foremost. It's service that puts us on an equal footing, it's mutual love. It is the mystery of the infinite Love of the Father and the Son, in the love that is the Holy Spirit, which gives face and meaning to everything, that we find ourselves in God. We ask for the grace to remain in love, the gift of God, and to put ourselves in the school of the very young and the poorest.

May we already receive him through the cup and bread we share, so that He may make us more and more like him, and so that we can say, like Saint Paul: *"I live, but it is no longer I, but Christ who lives in me."* (*Galatians 2:20*) Amen.

# Catechesis Spirituality

# This encounter that changes everything in a Christian's life, according to the Pope

"Everything changes if you've really come to know Jesus!" What changes with an encounter with Christ? Everything, absolutely everything, taught Pope Francis from the window of the Apostolic Palace in St Peter's Square last Sunday, September 15. Having returned from his long trip to Asia, Francis once again delivered his meditation on the day's Gospel, after the Angelus. *"To know the Lord, it is not enough to know something about Him, but it is necessary to follow Him, to let ourselves be touched and changed by His Gospel,"* he said.

Taking as his starting point the question "For you, who am I?" posed by Jesus to his disciples, according to the account in Mark's Gospel, Pope Francis noted that "Peter responds perfectly, telling Jesus that he is the Christ." But by refusing the prospect of his passage through the cross, he bears witness to an all-toohuman mentality, "which imagines a strong and victorious Messiah, who cannot suffer and die," the Pope remarked. Peter "still has to change his mentality, he still has to convert," explained Francis, inviting everyone to question their own prejudices.

### Let Jesus disturb you.

"We too have learned something about God, we know the doctrine, we recite the prayers correctly and, perhaps, to the question 'who is Jesus for you?' we answer well, with a formula we learned in catechism. But are we sure that this really means knowing Jesus?" he wondered.

In reality, "everything changes if you've really come to know Jesus!" assured Pope Francis. This encounter "changes your way of being, your way of thinking, the relationships you have with your brothers and sisters, your readiness to welcome and forgive, the choices you make in life," he insisted. The problem that never leaves me alone is that of knowing what Christianity really is for us today, or even who Christ is."

Rejecting the trap of a "quiet" life, Pope Francis called for introspection: "Do I let myself be disturbed, do I ask myself who Jesus is for me and what place he occupies in my life? He invited everyone to draw inspiration from the Virgin Mary, "who let God upset her plans and followed Jesus to the cross."




