The Kingdom of God is a kingdom of service, compassion, forgiveness and love.

Brothers and Sisters,

This Sunday marks the start of World Mission Week. It's also World Day to Overcome Extreme Poverty. We live in a world dominated by the pursuit of power and prestige. How can we be messengers of Christ if we don't go against this mentality?

In this Gospel, we see James and John, to be reassured, they ask Jesus to sit at his right and left in his kingdom.

In Christ's Church, we must renounce careers, titles and honorary positions altogether! The only principle is humble, fraternal service. To qualify the responsibility of those who play a particular role within the Christian community, we use the term "ministry," a word which means "service" in Latin! There are no "leaders" in the worldly sense in Christ's Church. There are only "ministers," "servants." That's why Christ recommended abolishing all fancy titles.

On the evening of Holy Thursday, "Jesus rose from the table, laid aside his garments and took an apron and girded himself with it" to wash his disciples' feet (John 13:4). Christ categorically excludes the worldly model of power from the Christian community: ***"Whoever wishes to become great shall be your servant. Whoever wants to be first will be slave of all."***

The Kingdom of God, whose coming we hope for every time we pray the Our Father ("Thy Kingdom come"), is a kingdom of service, compassion, forgiveness and love. And the greatest in this kingdom is the person who is ready to lend a hand, to share, to help. ***"Let him or her who wants to be the greatest make himself or herself the servant of all."***

Amen.

Catechesis

*The Exclamations of Saint Teresa of Avila are cries of love, desire, anguish and hope, quickly scribbled on scraps of paper after Communion.

A great Spanish mystic, the Church celebrated her this week on October 15. Her prayer is offered as a model for us in this year of the jubilee of hope:

"I am yours, since you created me; yours, since you redeemed me; yours, since you endured me; yours, since you called me; yours, since you waited for me; yours, since I was not lost.

What do you order to be done with me? Here is my heart, into your hands I commend it. Here is my body, my life, my soul, my love and affection. O sweet Spouse, my Redemption, since I am consecrated to you, what do you order to be done with me?

Give me death or life, give me health or sickness, give me honor or contempt, give me combat or perfect peace, weakness or fulfilled strength, since to all I say yes: what do you command to be done with me?

Give me wealth or poverty, give me consolation or desolation, give me joy or sadness, give me hell or give me heaven, my sweet life, O sun without veil, since I am all yours, what do you command to be done with me?

Give me wisdom or, for love, ignorance, give me years of plenty or famine. Give me darkness or bright day, toss me here or there. What do you command to be done with me? If you want me to rest, I want to rest for love. If you order me to work, I want to die working.

Tell me where, how and when? Speak, sweet Love, say: what do you command to be done with me? I am yours, for you I was born, what do you command to be done with me? So be it."

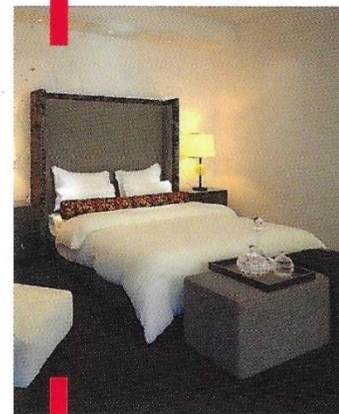
