

WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Zephaniah 3:14-18a

Responsorial Psalm: Isaiah 12:2-3, 4, 5-6

"Rejoice in the Lord always."

Brothers and Sisters,

Today is Gaudete Sunday, the "Sunday of Joy." If this Sunday is so designated, it's because the Word of God, which is proposed for our meditation today, invites us to joy. Right at the start of the first reading, we hear the words: "Shout for joy, Daughter of Zion! Break forth into ovations, O Israel! Rejoice with all your heart, leap for joy" (Zeph. 3:14). There is a kind of redundancy of joy in this reading. And the second reading is no exception. Saint Paul repeats: "Rejoice!"

However, we need to understand one thing: the joy to which we are invited is the very joy of the Lord. St. Paul tells us in no uncertain terms: "Rejoice in the Lord always" (Phil. 4:4). For, in truth, the joy that should dwell in us is the joy we can find in this Son of God who has chosen to be born among us. It is the very joy of God. It is the Lord himself who rejoices in us and for us.

On this 3rd Sunday of Advent C,

The crowds who came to be baptized by John the Baptist asked him three times, "What should we do?" John gives them some wise advice. To the baptized: "He who has two garments, let him share with him who has none; and he who has food, let him do likewise!" to the publicans: "Demand nothing more than what is set before you" and to the soldiers he will say: "Do no violence to anyone, accuse no one falsely; and be content with your pay." What about you and me, what should I do?

On this third Sunday of Advent, halfway through the celebration of the Nativity, each of us is invited to ask ourselves what we can do to make our hearts a worthy home for the Child of Bethlehem.

Amen!

The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of Marriage: Please make arrangements with the Pastor 6 months before your wedding by calling the church office.

Registration also helps in providing quick services for the request and proof of miscellaneous church letters for individuals, Baptism, Confirmation, etc.

Catechesis

What is the Third Sunday of Advent called?

The Third Sunday of Advent is also known as Gaudete Sunday. In fact, in the Roman Missal, the introit for this Sunday's Mass begins with the Latin phrase: "Gaudete in Domino semper: iterum dico, Gaudete" ("Rejoice in the Lord always; I repeat, rejoice!"). This phrase recalls the joy of the Church as it awaits the coming of Christ.

This is why liturgical vestments, which are purple throughout Advent, may exceptionally be pink on this day. For the same reason, pink vestments are also permitted on the Fourth Sunday of Lent.




