### WEEKLY REFLECTION

**First Reading:** Nehemiah 8:2-4a, 5-6, 8-10 **Responsorial Psalm:** Psalm 19:8, 9, 10, 15 **Second Reading:** 1 Corinthians 12:12-30

Gospel: Luke 1:1-4; 4:14-21 By Rev. Fr. Modeste Digwou

Beloved brothers and sisters, in communion with the Universal Church, we celebrate the 3rd Sunday of Ordinary Time, Year "C," and providentially it is the Sunday of the Word of God. On this Lord's Day, the Church invites us to rediscover the splendor of the Word of God, its flavor and its indispensability for the life of the world and of every human being. Far from being there to reduce man to a life of slavery, to enslave him and make him submit to a powerful and vengeful god, the Word of God is there, on the contrary, to lift man up, to give him back a smile, the joy of living and the hope of a better tomorrow with God.

Today's Gospel also presents us with an attentive liturgical assembly, their eyes riveted on Jesus. They are eager to hear him, and Jesus opens the book and reads from the prophet Isaiah. In it, the content of his mission is set out: the proclamation of the Good News. And this mission begins and is fully accomplished today. Here, it is no longer the ancient priests who do the reading, or the Levites who interpret it. Instead, it is Jesus Himself who speaks to us. Through Luke's mouth, he addresses you, dear Theophilus, you who love God. He invites you to listen carefully, to open your heart and stand in silence, to let yourself be embraced by the fire of his Love.

The Word of God is there to make us rich in God's life, to untie us from the bonds of sin that bind us and hold us captive, to open our eyes that are too often closed in on ourselves and prevent us from contemplating creation and God's love. It's there to help us finally break out of our prisons, our selfishness, our fears. The Word of God is there to help us break down the barriers of hatred that separate us. The Word of God aims to make us brothers, one people, one body in Jesus Christ, the Incarnate Word of God. In him, there is no longer any difference between us: there are no longer Jews and pagans. There are only the Sons of God, gathered into one Body. In Jesus we are all brothers (cf. 2nd reading).

Beloved of God, let us pray that the Lord may dispose our hearts even more to listen to His Word, that it may guide our lives and prepare us for the great encounter with Him in Heaven. Amen.

**Sacrament of Infant Baptism:** Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and god-parents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

**Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick:** Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 whenever a family member or friend is seriously ill or hospitalized.

**Healing Mass:** A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm.

**Visiting the Sick:** The parish priests visits the sick every Friday, please call the office with additional information.


