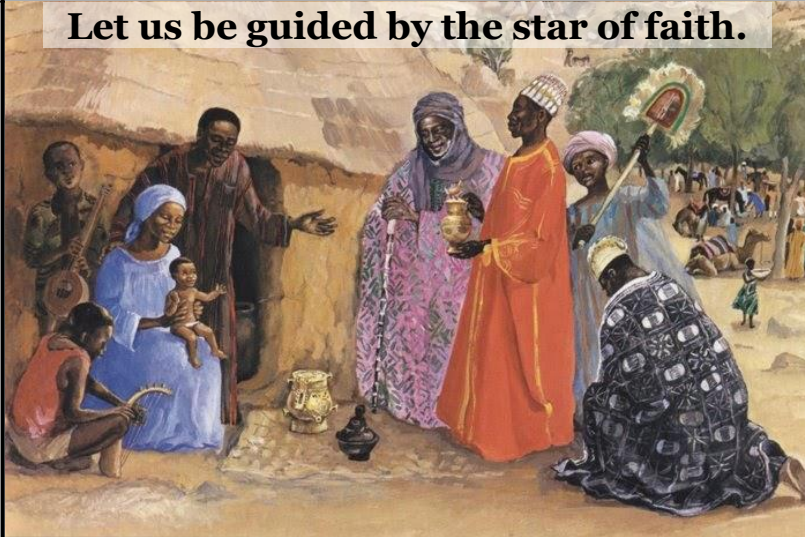

Let us be guided by the star of faith.

Today, the Church invites us to celebrate the solemnity of the Epiphany, the manifestation of God to all peoples. Today's readings encourage us to seek God. The Magi become the model for all Christians, who seek God along paths that are untrodden, but guided by the star of faith.

Yesterday as today, despite a world undergoing profound change, prey to murderous wars and various calamities, Christians continue to seek God, their Lord God. "You made us for you, Lord, and our heart is restless until it rests in you," confessed Saint Augustine. There is an inner thirst, an inner hunger, a deep lack of God within us that only He can fill.

Matthew's Gospel shows us how the Magi returned home by "another way." A true encounter with the Lord does not leave us indifferent! It changes us, transforms us and gives us a new direction. We can no longer take the same path. An encounter with the Lord often changes our ways and our way of doing things. It transforms us and changes our vision of the world and of things. Encountering the Lord leads us along His paths.

May the celebration of the Solemnity of the Epiphany, in the darkness of our world and sometimes of our lives, give us the courage to walk guided by the star of faith. May we be led to a life full of hope and joy, in the knowledge that the power of God has burst into the world through the birth of Jesus our Lord.

Sacrament of Infant Baptism: Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and godparents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 whenever a family member or friend is seriously ill or hospitalized.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the 4th Friday of every month at 6:00 pm.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visits the sick every Friday, please call the office with additional information.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

Sacrament of Marriage: Please make arrangements with the Pastor 6 months before your wedding by calling the church office.

Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are invited to register at the Church Office. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration also helps in providing quick services for the request and proof of miscellaneous church letters for individuals, Baptism, Confirmation, etc.

December 24: Opening of the Holy Door in St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. The event will follow a mass celebrated by Pope Francis.

January 24 to 26: Jubilee of the World of Communication.

- February 2025

February 8 and 9: Jubilee of the Armed Forces, Police and Security Agents

February 15 to 18: Artists' Jubilee

February 21 to 23: Jubilee of Deacons
