

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

On this Sunday, February 2, we celebrate the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple. The Church celebrates the day when Mary and Joseph presented the infant Jesus to the Temple in Jerusalem, in accordance with Jewish religious practice. This feast is well known as "Candlemas" or the festa candelarum, in Latin. In fact, the expression "candela" means candle. Today, thousands of candles will be blessed. This Sunday's liturgy includes a blessing of candles and a procession of light. In this atmosphere of candlelight, we are invited to contemplate and meditate on Jesus, "Light for the revelation of the world" as Simeon testified when he saw Christ: "My eyes have seen the light that is revealed to the nations." And so we are invited to be "light to the world" ourselves.

Today in the Church, we also celebrate the day of consecrated life. It's an opportunity to give thanks for the gift of religious life, knowing that consecrated life is above all the sign of the total gift we make of ourselves to the Lord from the day of our baptism. However, in today's Gospel, Anne and Simeon are presented to us as two consecrated people, in their own way. They both gave their lives to the Lord. They can be models for us of lives spent waiting for the Messiah. And they found consolation in carrying in their arms the One who is the Light of the world. Even today, Jesus still inspires men and women to offer their lives to him, and to become witnesses and bearers of Christ's Light to our world.

Dear brothers and sisters,

Let us welcome Jesus as the "Light of the World" into our lives. Let us implore his Spirit to dispel the darkness in our hearts, so that we may live our lives in hope of the Lord's coming. We pray Amen!

Sacrament of Infant Baptism: Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and god-parents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 whenever a family member or friend is seriously ill or hospitalized.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm.

THE MYSTERIES OF THE HOLY ROSARY 4th Joyful Mystery: Jesus is presented to the temple by Mary and Joseph.

"When the eighth day came, that of circumcision, the child received the name of Jesus, the name that the angel had given him before his conception. When the day appointed by the law of Moses for purification came, Jesus' parents brought him to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord, according to what is written in the Law: Every male firstborn will be consecrated to the Lord" (Lk 2, 21-24).

"The circumcision of Jesus, on the eighth day after his birth, is a sign of his insertion into the offspring of Abraham, into the people of the covenant, and his submission to the law" (CEC, n. 527).


