WEEKLY REFLECTION

Beloved in Christ, is God calling you? On this fifth Sunday in ordinary time year C, Mother Church invites us to reflect on discipleship. Vocation is a common thread running through all three of this Sunday's readings. A few points are to be considered as our spiritual nourishment:

1. God is the One who calls and no one else, He calls whoever He wants.
2. God's power is revealed in our weakness, unworthiness.
3. God calls mankind for conversion, then for a mission.
4. Trusting and obeying to God's word often leads to unexpected blessings.
5. Humility opens the door to transformation.
6. God calls ordinary people, simple people, unqualified people for extraordinary purpose.
7. Leaving your comfort behind helps to follow Christ.

We often struggle with this question: why does God chooses most of the time those that are unworthy, sinners, unqualified for his mission? The answer is pretty simple. He chooses unqualified/unworthy men and women; less they pride themselves before God.

Nowadays, many of our fellow brothers and sisters use their unworthiness as a means to run away from being committed in the building up of the kingdom of God in our parishes. Some do say for instance: I can't sing at all, that is why I can't be a choir member. The truth to the matter is that we all can sing. It is a matter of willingness. Once we make ourselves available, then we can learn what to do, how to do it and when to do it.

Many Catholics Christians often use excuses not to commit themselves, which is sad. Isaiah in the first reading mentioned his sinfulness, however his lips got purified by God for the mission. Paul from persecutor of the church got converted into the greater preacher and writer of the New Testament. Peter, in obeying the Lord's command has come to acknowledge his sinfulness before the Lord in the sight of the miraculous catch of fish.

What about you? What keeps you back from answering God's call and to commit in your parish community?

Sacrament of Infant Baptism: Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and godparents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. 3-Mental prayer (The Theresian approach)

We will continue diving into the forms of prayer in our next Bulletin.

Catechesis on prayer: “Lord, teach us how to pray”

Throughout this month of February, precisely each weekend catechesis will be focusing on one aspect of prayer as we will be diving into the mystery of prayer. It will be an opportunity to rediscover the value of prayer from different perspectives. Firstly, it will be important to ask ourselves what prayer really is; secondly, to be enlighten by the rich and diverse types of prayer in our catholic tradition. Thirdly, the highest form of prayer in our catholic tradition: The holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

In today’s Catechesis, we are going to commence with the definition of prayer according to a few saints and enumerate different aspects of prayer. **What is prayer?** There are different approaches.

1-Prayer is a mystery; it begins with is a life of faith in which the faithful conforms his life to Christ in the Holy Spirit to the glory of God the Father. This mystery, then, requires that the faithful believe in it, that they celebrate it, and that they live from it in a vital and personal relationship with the living and true God (Cf Catechism of the Catholic Church 2558).

Saint Therese of Lisieux, says: “For me, prayer is a surge of the heart; it is a simple look turned toward heaven, it is a cry of recognition and of love, embracing both trial and joy.

According to Saint John Damascene, “Prayer is the raising of one’s mind and heart to God or the requesting of good things from God.”

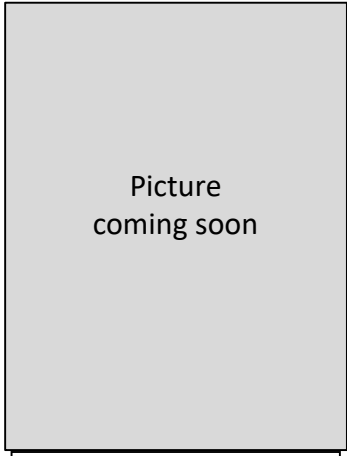
