WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Sirach 27:4-7

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 92:2-3, 13-14, 15-16

Gospel: Luke 6:39-45

Beloved in Christ risen from the dead, we live in a world of words thanks to modern mass media and, particularly, social media. We have seen the extremely harmful way in which words can be used in harsh judgement against other people, and the sheer sarcasm of some on social media gives us pause for thought. It prompts us to ask the question, implied in the first reading for today (Eccl 27:4-7), 'What do my words reveal about who I am?'

Today's Gospel is our final reading from Luke's Sermon on the Plain. This week, Jesus' radical teaching continues to focus on lavish generosity in our dealings with one another. The Gospel opens with a parable about one blind person leading another and both falling into a pit. The disciples, like ourselves, are on a lifelong journey with Jesus, our teacher. On this journey there is always more to discover, greater depths to be plumbed, new insights to be gained as we grow to be more like Jesus; as we move from being 'blind' to 'seeing' with the eyes of Jesus. We gradually learn to let go of our self-righteous inclination to judge small faults in others while never noticing our own larger, more destructive, blind spot.

When we learn God's way of mercy and generosity, we refrain from the kinds of judgements which would otherwise limit God's generosity, mercy and kindness at work in us. Our hearts are being built in goodness. Like trees that are known by their fruit, so will the disciples be known by their words and actions, their values and attitudes, by who they truly are, by what is in their heart. True spirituality begins not by pointing out people's flaws or unworthiness, rather by acknowledging our sinfulness before the holiness of God. In our rich Catholic tradition, the saints were very much concerned about their sins than that of others. We cannot and should not be willing to change others without being ourselves transformed by the Gospel. The more we grow closer to the Lord, the lesser we focus on others' sins, but ours. It is then, that we can help others to grow and to be converted. Our journey of learning with Jesus gradually builds God's heart within our own so that we live, speak and act, more and more, out of that great store of mercy and generosity. Free me Lord from the blindness which clouds my vision and limits my love. Help me to see as you see, and act with your kindness and compassion. Amen.

Sacrament of Infant Baptism: Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and god-parents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 whenever a family member or friend is seriously ill or hospitalized.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visits the sick every Friday, please call the office with additional information.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

Catechesis

What is prayer? "Lord, teach us how to pray"

Last weekend, our catechesis was focused on the five forms of prayer. Three forms were presented namely: prayer blessing and adoration; prayer of petition and prayer of intercession. Today, our focus will on prayer of thanksgiving and prayer of praise.

PRAYER OF THANKSGIVING

Thanksgiving characterizes the prayer of the Church which, in celebrating the Eucharist, reveals and becomes more fully what she is. Indeed, in the work of salvation, Christ sets creation free from sin and death to consecrate it anew and make it return to the Father, for his glory. The thanksgiving of the members of the Body participates in that of their Head.

As in the prayer of petition, every event and need can become an offering of thanksgiving. The letters of St. Paul often begin and end with thanksgiving, and the Lord Jesus is always present in it: "Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you"; "Continue steadfastly in prayer, being watchful in it with thanksgiving."

PRAYER OF PRAISE

Mother church teaches us that, Praise is the form of prayer which recognizes most immediately that God is God. It lauds God for his own sake and gives him glory, quite beyond what he does, but simply because HE IS. It shares in the blessed happiness of the pure of heart who love God in faith before seeing him in glory. Praise embraces the other forms of prayer and carries them toward him who is its source and goal: the "one God, the Father, from whom are all things and for whom we exist."

Besides the five forms of prayer, it is also important to mention that prayer is not only vocal, but also mental. Saint Therese of Jesus, Doctor of the church leads us into this wonderful way of entering in depth with the Lord as a Friend. She said I quote: "For *mental prayer in my opinion is nothing else than an intimate sharing between friends; it means taking time frequently to be alone with Him who we know loves us.*" **St. Teresa of Avila: The Book of Her Life**, ch. 8, 5. In this sense, mental prayer is about loving more than merely uttering words.
