### WEEKLY REFLECTION

**First Reading:** Genesis 15:5-12, 17-18

**Responsorial Psalm:** Psalm 27:1, 7-8, 8-9, 13-14

**Second Reading:** Philippians 3:17-4:1

**Gospel:** Luke 9:28b-36

**From the desert to the mountain of the transfiguration.**

Brothers and sisters,

Last Sunday, Jesus led us to the desert; this week he leads us to the mountain.

**Lent is now well underway.** We've been **in the desert** with Christ, a place of asceticism and temptation, but also a place of prayer and victory. Now he's taking us further. He takes us with him up **the mountain** to pray.

The mountain is another place of intimacy with God, a special place. It's a special place. It's not about getting closer to heaven, as in natural religions. God doesn't depend on places to manifest Himself. It's us who need to be carried. On the mountain, we see life from a distance, away from the hustle and bustle of the world, the hubbub of worries, the futility of concerns that aren't worth the trouble. On the mountain, nature calms down, leaving only the whisper of the wind. **On the mountain, you can see far behind and far ahead.**

**This is what happened at the Transfiguration.** The Apostles Peter, John and James were led by Jesus to step back from their mission, their teaching and the hostility to Jesus that was beginning to emerge. They were invited to a moment of intimacy, to enter into the cloud of God's presence, characteristic of the people's experience in the desert of old. They were invited to look far behind, with Moses and Elijah, to their spiritual roots, and also far ahead, with Christ, to their Salvation that was to be accomplished in Jerusalem, and to their glorification.

**We are invited to experience the same thing as we walk towards Easter.** Let's climb the mountain. Let's step back. Let's put aside our worries for a while this Sunday. Let's give God the opportunity to manifest himself in the cloud. Let's stop and pray. Let us open our Bibles to encounter Christ in the words of the prophets. Let us look far ahead, to see beyond our worries and perhaps our suffering, to catch a glimpse of Christ's victory.

### Prayer of the Sick for the Time of the Jubilee

(To be recited after communion during this month of March dedicated for the sick)

O Virgin Mary, Health of the sick you who accompanied Jesus on the way to Calvary and who remained at the foot of the cross where your Son died by participating intimately in his sufferings, welcome our sufferings and unite them with his so that the seeds sown during the Jubilee continue to produce abundant fruits during the coming years.

Very tender mother, we address You. Obtain us from your Son to be able to return to our occupations soon, after a complete recovery to make ourselves useful to others through our work. For now, stay with us at the time of the test and help us to repeat every day with You our yes, sure that God will know how to get a much greater out of trouble.

Immaculate Virgin, let the fruits of the Jubilee Year be for us and for those who are dear to us the pledge of a renewed momentum in our Christian life, so that we may find the abundance of God's mercy in the contemplation of the Face of the risen Christ, as well as the joy of a more total communion with the brothers, the beginnings of the endless joy of Heaven.

**Sacrament of Infant Baptism:** Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and god-parents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes:** RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

**CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation:** CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

**Sacrament of Penance:** Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

# Catechesis

**\*In Lent, rediscover silence as the seed of unity\*.**

Saint Benedict suggests that we at least give Lent a try, by rediscovering silence as the seed of unity.

## ***Lent, a time for prayer***

Christians are invited to pray to God as “our” Father. For Lent to be a privileged time for prayer, it must also become a time devoted to strengthening this “we.”

In the darkness of deep silence, the road ahead becomes clear, and that’s enough.

How can we pray by saying “we” when we are so divided?

How can this “we” strike the vault of our churches?

## ***\_ .....Silence....\_***

How can silence strengthen this “we”? To receive it, we must be silent and listen. Silence the complaints generated by difficulties that overwhelm us, by unexpected disappointments, whenever events surprise us or others around us don’t react as we expect. Silence the false ambitions that inhabit us, silence the projects that derail us,

## ***\_... and listen\_***

Listen to the Word of God. Really listen to it, when it upsets and disturbs us, when it comforts us and strengthens us in the truth. Listen to those we don’t understand, because they have something to tell us.

## ***\_....Be silent and listen,***

especially in prayer, before the tabernacle where the risen Jesus speaks to us in silence. Silence our feelings. Quiet our restlessness. Quiet even our beautiful thoughts. Quiet the automatic prayers of self-preoccupation. Silence all that, to rediscover the confidence of the child who holds his Father’s hand and asks for nothing more than his presence.

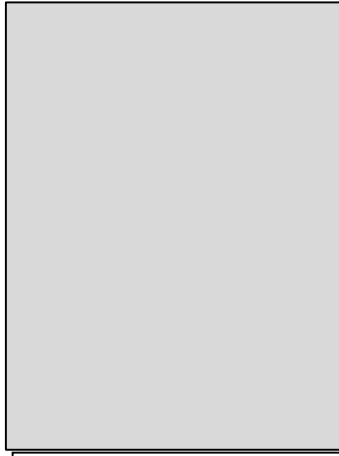

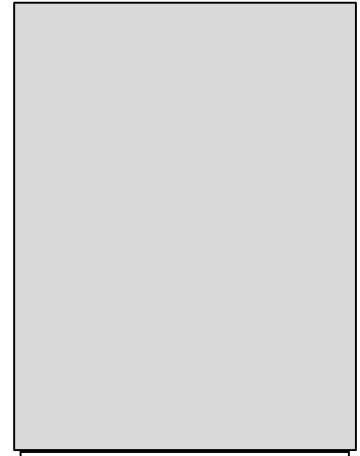

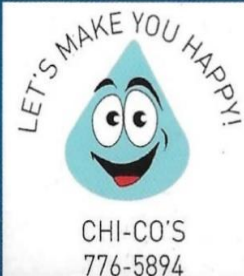
