

WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Deuteronomy 26:4-10

Pope Francis' message for Lent 2025 summarized by Fr. Modeste Digwou **Let us walk together in hope** is the theme for the Lenten season.

Dear brothers and sisters,

HE begins his letter as follows: "With the penitential sign of ashes on our heads, we begin the annual pilgrimage of Holy Lent in faith and hope. The Church, mother and teacher, invites us to prepare our hearts and open ourselves to God's grace, so that we can joyfully celebrate Christ the Lord's Paschal triumph over sin and death. Saint Paul proclaims: 'Death has been swallowed up in victory. O Death, where is your victory? O Death, where is your sting?' (1 Cor 15:54-55). Indeed, Jesus Christ, dead and risen, is the center of our faith and the guarantor of the Father's great promise of eternal life already realized in his beloved Son (cf. Jn 10:28; 17:3)."

During this Lent, enriched by the grace of the Jubilee Year, the Pope would like to offer some reflections on what it means to walk together in hope, and discover the calls to conversion that God's mercy addresses to everyone, as individuals and as communities.

He sees this as "the vocation of the Church." Walking together, Francis continues, "means moving forward side by side, without trampling or dominating the other, without harboring envy or hypocrisy, without leaving anyone behind or feeling excluded."

His message is based on three fundamental points

Firstly, to "WALK," the pilgrim of hope, in life, we are all pilgrims. We can all ask ourselves: how do I allow myself to be challenged by this condition? Am I really on the road, or rather paralyzed, static, fearful and lacking in hope, or still settled in my comfort zone? Am I looking for ways to free myself from situations of sin and lack of dignity?

Secondly, "FAISONS CHEMIN ENSEMBLE" is about moving forward together, walking together, being synodal - this is the vocation of the Church. [2] Christians are called to journey together, never as lone travelers. This Lent, God is asking us to check whether in our lives, in our families, in the places where we work, in our parish or religious communities, we are capable of walking with others, of listening, of overcoming the temptation to anchor ourselves in our self-referentiality and concern ourselves only with our own needs. Let us ask ourselves before the Lord if we are capable of working together – bishops, priests, consecrated persons and lay people – in the service of the Kingdom of God:

Thirdly, "LET US MAKE THIS JOURNEY TOGETHER IN THE HOPE OF A **PROMISE**" This call is one of hope, of trust in God and in his great promise, eternal life. We must ask ourselves: do I have the conviction that God forgives my sins? Or am I acting as if I can save myself?

May the Virgin Mary, Mother of Hope, intercede for us and accompany us on our Lenten journey.

Prayer of the sick for the time of the Jubilee

(To be recited after communion during this month of March dedicated for the sick)

O Virgin Mary, Health of the sick you who accompanied Jesus on the way to Calvary and who remained at the foot of the cross where your Son died by participating intimately in his sufferings, welcome our sufferings and unite them with his so that the seeds sown during the Jubilee continue to produce abundant fruits during the coming years.

Very tender mother, we address You. Obtain us from your Son to be able to return to our occupations soon, after a complete recovery to make ourselves useful to others through our work. For now, stay with us at the time of the test and help us to repeat every day with You our yes, sure that God will know how to get a much greater out of trouble.

Immaculate Virgin, let the fruits of the Jubilee Year be for us and for those who are dear to us the pledge of a renewed momentum in our Christian life, so that we may find the abundance of God's mercy in the contemplation of the Face of the risen Christ, as well as the joy of a more total communion with the brothers, the beginnings of the endless joy of Heaven.

Sacrament of Infant Baptism: Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and god-parents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. 1. Mardi Gras (Fat Tuesday): Tuesday March 4, 2025

It is the last day before Lent, marked by festivities and celebrations before fasting and penance.

2. Ash Wednesday (early Lent): Wednesday March 5, 2025

Day of fasting and abstinence. The faithful receive the ashes on the front as a sign of repentance and a conversion process.

3. Lent time (40 days of preparation at Easter): from March 5 to April 17, 2025

The faithful are invited to pray, fast and do alms to prepare for the celebration of the resurrection of Christ.

4. Lenten Sundays

1st Sunday of Lent: Sunday March 9, 2025 2nd Sunday of Lent: Sunday March 16, 2025 3rd Sunday of Lent: Sunday March 23, 2025 4th Sunday of Lent (Laetare): Sunday March 30, 2025

5. Holy Week




