WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Genesis 14:18-20

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 110:1, 2, 3, 4

Today, the Universal Church celebrates the **Feast of Corpus Christi**, honoring the **Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ**. This solemnity is a joyful reflection on the **gift of the Eucharist**, where Jesus gives Himself to us under the forms of **bread and wine**. Traditionally celebrated on the **Thursday after Trinity Sunday**, the feast has medieval origins.

It began through the efforts of **St. Juliana of Cornillon**, a Belgian nun who, inspired by a vision from the Lord, advocated for a liturgical feast dedicated to the **Holy Eucharist**. The feast was further affirmed by a **Eucharistic miracle** in **Bolsena, Italy**, involving a German priest, **Fr. Peter of Prague**, who doubted Christ's real presence in the Eucharist. During Mass, after the consecration, **blood miraculously seeped from the host**, affirming the truth of Christ's presence and strengthening the faith of many.

The readings center on the profound meaning of the **Eucharist**, especially as celebrated on **Corpus Christi**. The **first reading from Genesis** presents **Melchizedek**, a priest-king who offers **bread and wine**, symbolizing and foreshadowing the **Holy Eucharist** instituted by Christ. This act connects worship with sacrifice.

In the **second reading from Corinthians**, **St. Paul recalls the Last Supper**, where Jesus gives His Body and Blood as spiritual nourishment, establishing the **new covenant**. The Eucharist is emphasized as central to Christian faith—uniting believers, nourishing souls, and calling for a response of **gratitude, love, and service**.

The reflection urges believers to approach the Eucharist with **reverence, faith, and openness**, seeing it not as routine but as a **transformative encounter with the living God**. It challenges us to reflect on how we live out this sacrament daily—becoming **bearers of Christ's love and mercy** in the world, allowing ourselves to be offered, even broken for others.

Ultimately, the Eucharist is described as a **sacrament of unity**, drawing us closer to Christ and to one another. Celebrating **Corpus Christi** becomes a moment of **spiritual renewal**, inspiring deeper devotion, and a commitment to bring Christ to those in need.

Parish Information

Sacrament of Infant Baptism: Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and god-parents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 whenever a family member or friend is seriously ill or hospitalized.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visits the sick every Friday, please call the office with additional information.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

Sacrament of Marriage: Please make arrangements with the Pastor 6 months before your wedding by calling the church office.

Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are invited to register at the Church Office. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration also helps in providing quick services for the request and proof of miscellaneous church letters for individuals, Baptism, Confirmation, etc.

Catechesis

Catechesis on the Reverence of the church and the Eucharist

As **Catholic Christians**, we recognize that **churches are holy ground**, where the divine and human meet. When a church is consecrated by a bishop and the **Blessed Sacrament** is present, it becomes a sacred space that demands **reverence and respect**. This understanding of holy ground is rooted in biblical traditions, such as **Moses’ encounter with the burning bush** (Exodus 3:2-5), where he was told to remove his sandals, acknowledging the holiness of its surrounding.

In the **Old Testament**, the **Temple in Jerusalem** was considered sacred, housing the **Ark of the Covenant**, which contained the **Ten Commandments**. However, with the **Incarnation**—when God became man in Jesus Christ—the true holiness now resides in the **Eucharist**, making our **churches** and the **Blessed Sacrament** the focal point of sacred worship.

Guidelines for Reverence in Church:

Upon Entry:

- 1. Genuflect or Bow:** Show respect by genuflecting (or bowing if physical limitations prevent genuflection) towards the **Tabernacle**, which houses the Blessed Sacrament.
- 2. Make the Sign of the Cross:** Acknowledge the **Blessed Trinity** and God's presence in the church.
- 3. Silence Mobile Devices:** Turn off or silence phones to preserve the prayerful atmosphere.
- 4. Respect Others’ Prayer:** Avoid disturbing those already in prayer; quietly find a seat and begin your own prayer.

- 5. Maintain a Prayerful Atmosphere:** Avoid loud conversations and unnecessary noise, keeping the space focused on worship.
 - 6. Arrive Early for Devotions:** Arriving early allows time for personal prayer, such as praying the **rosary**, before Mass begins.
 - 7. Dress Modestly:** Wear appropriate attire that reflects reverence, avoiding overly casual or revealing clothing.
 - 8. No Texting or Phone Calls:** Phones should not be used for texting or calls during Mass

Before Receiving Holy Communion:

- 1. Be in a State of Grace:** Ensure you’re free from mortal sin. If needed, consider going to **Confession** before receiving the Eucharist.
- 2. Fast from Food and Drink:** Observe the **one-hour fast** before receiving Communion, with exceptions for water and medicine.
- 3. Avoid Distractions:** Remain focused and reverent, refraining from unnecessary movements or gestures during the reception of Communion.

After Receiving Holy Communion:

- 1. Spend Time in Thanksgiving:** After receiving Christ in the Eucharist, take a moment to thank God for the gift of His Body and Blood, reflecting on the mystery of the **Eucharist** and its power to transform you spiritually.
