Celebrating the Birth of the Church: A Reflection on Pentecost

As we gather to celebrate the solemnity of Pentecost, we are reminded that the Church was born on this day, empowered by the Holy Spirit to proclaim God's deeds of power to people from every nation. Just as birthdays are cherished by individuals, we, as the people of God, celebrate our own spiritual birthday, marked by the day our names were written in the Book of Life through Baptism.

A Universal Gathering

The Church is a gathering (Ecclesia) of people from the four corners of the globe, a universality of cultures, tribes, and languages. It is not a social club or an elite group, but a field hospital for the sick (terminology proper to Pope Francis), where sinners are called to repentance and healing. The readings today remind us that diversity is not a threat, but a sign of blessings, an opportunity to grow, learn from others, as we remain unique in the eyes of God.

Empowered by the Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit empowers us to be witnesses to God's love and mercy, giving us diverse gifts for the common good. These gifts can take many forms, such as teaching, prophecy, healing, or service. We are all called to use these gifts to build up the body of Christ and to serve others. As St. Paul reminds us, "To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good."

Forgiveness and Reconciliation

In the Gospel, Jesus breathes the Holy Spirit onto the disciples, giving them the authority to forgive sins and continue his mission of teaching and forgiveness. This gift of forgiveness is at the heart of our faith, empowering us to bring healing and reconciliation to a world wounded by sin and rift. As members of the body of Christ, we are called to work together, using our gifts to serve others. A few questions to continue our meditation: May this Pentecost celebration be a time of spiritual renewal and growth, as we reflect on the transformative power of the Holy Spirit in our lives.

- How has the Holy Spirit guided me in my life?
- What gifts has the Spirit given me, and how can I use them to serve others?
- How can I work towards unity and reconciliation in my relationships and community?
- What does forgiveness mean to me, and how can I extend it to others?

Sacrament of Infant Baptism: Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and god-parents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion.
