### WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading Dt 30:10-14

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 69:14,17,30-31,33-34,36,37

Second Reading: Colossians 1:15-20

**Gospel:** Luke 10:25-37 By Father Yacob Lonfo

As we gather this Sunday, the readings gently guide us to reflect on compassion, intimacy with God, and living our faith through tangible actions. In the Gospel of Luke (10:25–37), the parable of the Good Samaritan unfolds as a timeless invitation to love without borders, to transcend the boundaries that divide us.

In Deuteronomy 30:10–14, we're reminded that God's commandments aren't distant or obscure; they're inscribed in our hearts, a gentle whisper that echoes within us. We were created in God's image and likeness, and Moses teaches us that we don't need to search the heavens or cross vast seas to find God's will – it's already within us, accessible through love and obedience. St. Paul's words resonate deeply: Christ is the visible image of the invisible God. This sacred truth reminds us that we, too, are the image of Christ on earth, called to reflect His love and compassion.

The parable of the Good Samaritan poses a profound question: Who is my neighbor? The Samaritan, an outsider, sees a stranger in need and responds with kindness, without questioning identity, beliefs, or background. He embodies the essence of compassion, showing us that love knows no bounds. As we ponder this parable, let's ask ourselves: Have we ever contributed to someone's pain, physically or emotionally? How can we be instruments of healing and love?

Saint Thérèse of Lisieux's words echo through the ages: "Love proves itself by deeds." Saint Vincent de Paul lived this truth, serving the poor with tireless devotion. May we, too, find holiness in the ordinary – through acts of kindness, sacrifice, and mercy.

Lord, guide us to see You in every person we meet. May we not pass by like the priest or Levite, but stop, care, and love like the Good Samaritan. Teach us to live Your law written in our hearts, and to be neighbors to all, without exception.

**Sacrament of Infant Baptism:** Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and god-parents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. 
