Dear brothers and sisters, on this Sunday, the Lord asks us to stay awake and keep our lamp burning. But what does this mean for us today? The lighted lamp is our faith, symbolized by the candle we received on the day of our baptism. This lamp must remain lit. And our faith must remain alive and active despite the weight of expectation. We are called today to remain firm in our faith and joyful in our hope, so as not to become discouraged, even if things are slow in coming to pass. In the book of Wisdom, we see how faith had sustained the assurance of the Fathers despite the ordeal of the night of Paschal deliverance. And the letter to the Hebrews presents us with Abraham's irresistible faith as he left his country, obeying God's call and promise.

On this Sunday, let us pray that we know how to use the goods that the Lord places at our disposal, always remaining in the garb of service. Lord, may your love be upon us, as our hope is in you.


