"I have come to bring a fire to the earth, and how I wish it was already lit." Jesus proclaimed: "Blessed are the peacemakers." He who appeared "to guide our steps on a road of peace," he "who is our peace," tells us that fidelity to his Gospel will lead his disciples to be misunderstood. It will be for them to be rejected even by those who are dearest to them. The Word of Jesus at work in our hearts will lead us to make choices that counter-slope to certain comforts of life or thought of our group. To the commitment of Jesus up to the Cross for the salvation of the world will have to respond to the courage of the baptized to testify to him even in family life. The victory will be to bring the peace of Jesus in a family divided by the trial. What a suffering for Jesus to wait for this baptism, which first expresses his Passion and Resurrection, to be accomplished in us. It is an anguished pain that we can understand because we must consent to the salvation brought by Jesus. We live in anguish before the darkness that inhabits us before taking the path of Peace. We want to put ourselves in the school of Jesus, waiting for God's patience in the night of faith. We experience that our life is inhabited by a fire of love that attracts us to God: "Come to the Father."

Mary as Mother of God and Mother of the Church.




