

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The parable of this Sunday's Gospel may sound like a strategy for public life or, at the very least, like a set of rules of decency. "When someone invites you to a wedding, do not settle in the first place..."; "When you give lunch or dinner, do not invite your friends or your brothers..." Is Jesus' teaching only aimed at avoiding public ridicule? To understand this parable in this way is not to grasp the essential message of this Sunday's readings. Indeed, the key to reading these texts is given to us in the verse of the acclamation that precedes the reading of the Gospel: "become my disciples, for I am gentle and humble of heart."

Becoming a disciple of Jesus is not only about listening to his word; being a Christian is about modeling one's own life on that of Jesus. In a word, to be a Christian is to become another Christ.

The grace we have to ask of the Lord on this Sunday is to grow in each of us the Christ virtue of humility. May this virtue become the mark of our Christian life, so that we may be true disciples of the one who is gentle and humble of heart. Amen!

Parish Information

Sacrament of Infant Baptism: Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and godparents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 whenever a family member or friend is seriously ill or hospitalized.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visits the sick every Friday, please call the office with additional information.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

Sacrament of Marriage: Please make arrangements with the Pastor 6 months before your wedding by calling the church office.

Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are invited to register at the Church Office. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration also helps in providing quick services for the request and proof of miscellaneous church letters for individuals, Baptism, Confirmation, etc.

Cleaning of the Church: The church is cleaned every Friday of the Month at 6:30 p.m. Volunteers are needed and welcomed.

Catechesis

*How to make praying the Rosary easier (continued)

The mysteries of the Rosary hold up a mirror to our own existence

The joyful mysteries express the early joy felt by believers in the first years of their conversion. It's always a good idea to remember these early impulses, so that our faith doesn't rust under the effects of habit and inertia. In the Bible, the Lord asks Israel to remember the time of their betrothal in the desert (Hos 2:17). The first series of mysteries in the Rosary bring to life the first times when Jesus revealed himself to us, or when Christian truths appeared to us in a new light, or when the Son of God suddenly became a living person for us, as he was for Mary at the Annunciation.

Through the Luminous Mysteries, Christians meditate on how to live their faith day by day. They think about reactivating their baptismal promises, praying to Mary, converting themselves by reading the Word of God, savoring moments of inner transfiguration — brief but already prophetic of their eternal glorification — and finally, not forgetting the Bread for the road: the Eucharist.

A supernatural foretaste

The sorrowful mysteries remind us that life on earth is marked by suffering. Yet, thanks to them, the Christian is able to give a redemptive meaning to his own. Life has a dramatic aspect, with eternity at stake. Existence is a struggle for light. To ignore this dramatic dimension would be to relegate Christianity to the level of mere humanitarianism. However, the episodes of the Passion are secretly imbued with joy, because the thought of the Resurrection illuminates them in anticipation. It is on this condition that the Christian is able to give hope to the world.


