

WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Numbers 21:4b-9

Responsorial Psalm: 78:1bc-2, 34-35, 36-37, 38

Second Reading: Philippians 2:6-11

Gospel: John 3:13-17 By Father Yacob Lonfo

Meditation for the Feast of the Exaltation/ Triumph of the Holy Cross.

Beloved in Christ Jesus, it is rare for us to celebrate the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross on a Sunday. This feast commemorates the dedication, in 335, of the Church of the Holy Sepulcher built on the site of the Crucifixion by the Emperor Constantine. Also, the discovery of the Lord's Cross by St. Helena on August 18, 320. There is a very clear relationship between the first reading (Numbers 21:4-9) and the Gospel. The people in the first reading are healed by looking at a bronze serpent lifted up in their midst by Moses. Jesus says in the Gospel that he, too, must be lifted up so that all who believe may have life. The second reading is the beautiful hymn from the letter to the Philippians (2:6-11). It is about God who willingly gives up his divinity in Christ to become one of us, accepting death on the cross to show the depth of God's love.

The cross is a symbol full of contradictions: an instrument of cruelty and torture, and yet the means of saving love; an instrument of shame and death, yet the way of restoring true dignity and life; an instrument of hatred and contempt, yet the strongest symbol of Love. The symbol of the cross also carries the mixed realities of human life: moments of crucifixion and resurrection, moments of sorrow and joy, moments of suffering and healing, moments of hatred and reconciliation.

We use the Cross continually in our Christian tradition. We use it to mark the beginning and end of prayer and the Eucharist. It marks the beginning and end of our Christian journey in Baptism and the Funeral Rites. So, we use the Cross in moments of joy and gladness and sorrow and distress. The Cross draws us into moments of deep awareness of the mystery of God's love for us. It reminds us that suffering and death are not the end of our story, that life and healing can come out of darkness and pain, that God in Christ remains faithful to us even to death and beyond. Today we rejoice in a God who loves us that much and pray that we may be a continuing source of love, life and healing for one another.

Parish Information

Sacrament of Infant Baptism: Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and god-parents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 whenever a family member or friend is seriously ill or hospitalized.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visits the sick every Friday, please call the office with additional information.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

Sacrament of Marriage: Please make arrangements with the Pastor 6 months before your wedding by calling the church office. Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are invited to register at the Church Office. We would like to maintain

invited to register at the Church Office. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration also helps in providing quick services for the request and proof of miscellaneous church letters for individuals, Baptism, Confirmation, etc.

Cleaning of the Church: The church is cleaned every Friday of the Month at 6:30 p.m. Volunteers are needed and welcomed.

Church Registration: If you are not registered as church member, please do so now. Adult children in households must register separately. Also, if you have relocated or if your mailing address has changed, please update it at the church office any Wednesday.

Communication from our Bishop: Our bishop would like Christians to remain kneeling after receiving communion until the rest of the communion is returned to the tabernacle, to mark the time of adoration and meditation.

Catechesis

Catechesis on the Devotion to Our Lady Of Sorrows

Our Lady of Sorrows, also known as *Mater Dolorosa* in *Latin*, is a title given to the Virgin Mary. This devotion focuses on Mary's suffering during the life and crucifixion of her Son: in other words Mary's spiritual martyrdom. It's observed in the Catholic Church with a feast on September 15th, the day after the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross.

The devotion to Our Lady of Sorrows has deep roots in the Catholic tradition, dating back to the thirteenth century. It began with the Servite Order, founded in 1223 by seven noblemen from Florence (Italy) who had a special a special devotion to the Sorrows of Mary. However, it wasn't until 1668 that Pope Clement X officially designated September as the Month of Our Lady of Sorrows, with her feast day falling on September 15th.

The Seven Sorrows of Mary which are: the Prophecy of Simeon (Lk 2: 34-35); the Flight into Egypt (Mt 2: 13-13); the Loss of the Child Jesus in the Temple (Lk 2:43-45); Mary meets Jesus on the way to Calvary (Lk 23:26-27); Jesus dies on the Cross (Jn 19:25-30); Mary receives the Body of Jesus in her arms (Mt 27: 57-59); the Body of Jesus is placed in the tomb (Jn 19: 40-42); represent a profound trial in Mary's life, from the foreshadowing of her Son's suffering to the ultimate pain of witnessing his death and burial.

Mary's example provides a model for all Christians on how to face suffering with dignity, faith and hope. Her unwavering trust in God's plan, even in the face of unimaginable pain offer comfort and inspiration to those facing their own trials. In our modern world, often characterized by suffering and uncertainty, the devotion to Our Lady of Sorrows takes on renewed significance. It reminds us that pain and sorrow are universal human experiences, but they need not lead to despair.

Moreover, this devotion encourages empathy and compassion. By meditating on Mary's sorrows, we are reminded of the suffering of others and called to offer comfort and support to those in pain. The novena to Our Lady Of Sorrows should starts on Sept. 6th and end on Sept. 14th, Feast day of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross.


