



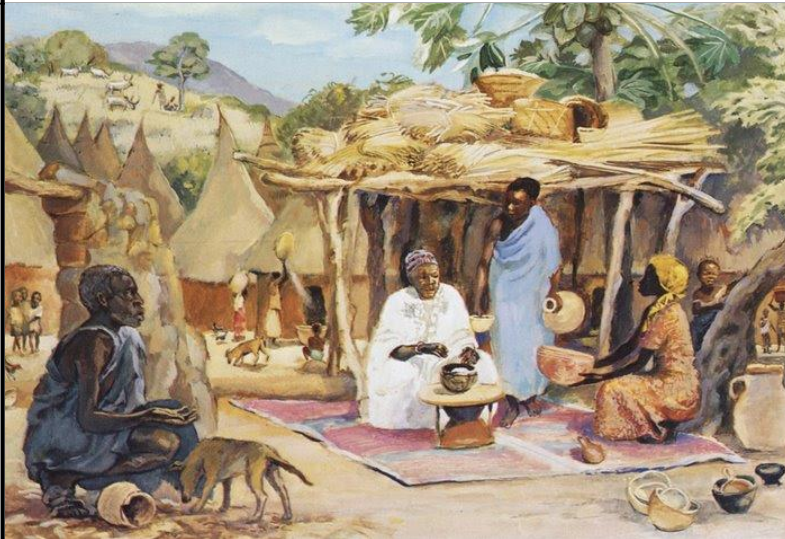

WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Amos 6:1a, 4-7

Responsorial Psalm:

Psalm 146:7, 8-9, 9-10

Second Reading: 1 Timothy 6:11-16

Gospel: Luke 16:19-31

Today, Mother Church observes the World Day of Migrants and Refugees, a poignant reminder of our shared humanity. Pope Francis' message emphasizes four key actions: welcoming, protecting, promoting, and integrating those in need.

The first reading from Amos critiques the complacency of the wealthy who prioritize their own comfort while neglecting the poor. Amos warns that those who ignore the poor will face exile, highlighting the consequences of indifference.

In the Gospel, Jesus echoes Amos, emphasizing the importance of sharing with those in need. The parable of the rich man and Lazarus serves as a call to action, reminding us that blessings come with responsibilities. It's not wrong to be wealthy, especially when wealth does not come from stealing or exploiting others. But neglecting the poor is a grave sin against God and against the "other," which is the sin of omission.

We often find excuses to avoid helping those in need, forgetting that the poor are our path to the Lord and heaven. The parable urges us to seek the Lord while He can be found and to live with mercy and justice. As Pope Paul VI said, "If you want peace, work for justice."

We're called to share God's blessings, ensuring everyone has dignity and respect. Remember, what we have in surplus belongs to the poor. Let's not neglect showing hospitality, for we might unknowingly entertain angels, as Scripture reminds us: "Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for by doing so, some have entertained angels without knowing it" (Hebrews 13:2).

May we reflect on our actions and strive to create a more just and compassionate world, where everyone is treated with dignity and respect.

Parish Information

Sacrament of Infant Baptism: Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and god-parents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 whenever a family member or friend is seriously ill or hospitalized.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visits the sick every Friday, please call the office with additional information.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

Sacrament of Marriage: Please make arrangements with the Pastor 6 months before your wedding by calling the church office.

Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are invited to register at the Church Office. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration also helps in providing quick services for the request and proof of miscellaneous church letters for individuals, Baptism, Confirmation, etc.

Cleaning of the Church: The church is cleaned every Friday of the Month at 6:30 p.m. Volunteers are needed and welcomed.

Catechesis on the Angels

Let's explore the fascinating world of angels! As we celebrate the feast of the Archangels Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael on September 29th, we're reminded of the special role these spiritual beings play in our lives.

Angels are messengers of God's love and providence, serving as guardians, guides, and protectors. They're pure spirits, without physical bodies, but can take on visible forms when God wills it.

The word "angel" comes from the Greek "angelos," meaning messenger. St. Augustine beautifully explains that "angel" is their office, not their nature – their nature is spirit, and their role is to serve God's plan.

We have guardian angels assigned to us from birth, watching over us and carrying our prayers to God. They're present in the liturgy, singing with us in the Sanctus: "Holy, Holy, Holy Lord..."

As we reflect on the angels' role, let's ask ourselves: How can we become like angels, serving one another and fulfilling God's will? Let's cherish our guardian angels and respect their role in our lives. May we be inspired by the angels' devotion to God and their care for us, and may we strive to serve others with love and kindness.

Here's a traditional prayer to our guardian angel:

"Angel of God, my guardian dear, To whom God's love commits me here, Ever this day be at my side, To light and guard, to rule and guide. Amen."

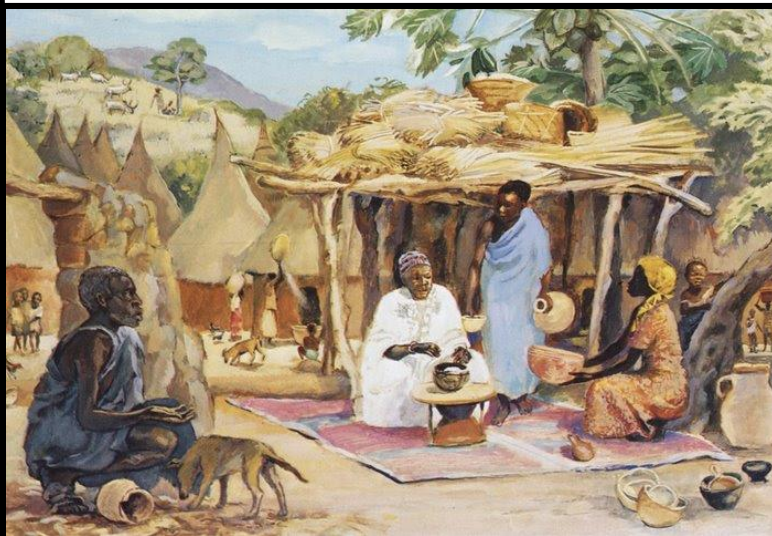
