WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Wisdom 9:13-18b

Today's Gospel contains a heavy dose of real reality about what is required in order to be a disciple of Jesus. The words of Jesus have to be read against the background of the Kingdom God is inviting us into and the central message of Jesus that we need to place God in the center of our hearts. The language about hating family members and even our own lives comes from a Semitic *idiom* which expresses **preference**. If you prefer one person or thing over another you are said to 'love' the first and 'hate' the second.

The Gospel is not calling us to hate either our relatives or ourselves. When we let the presence of God flood our hearts and minds all other aspects of our lives, including our relationships, find their proper place. Relationships become more genuine and less exploitive; possessions have less hold over us and we begin to share them more generously, our need for power and status fades.

To do this, however, it's not an easy thing. It requires many daily decisions, choosing to see with God's eyes, to feel with God's heart and to act according to God's vision for human life: to choose love over hate, generosity over hoarding, to let go of power and status and be of real service to our sisters and brothers. That is what 'carrying the cross' is all about. Jesus warns that this is a difficult and demanding way, and that a disciple needs to be clear-eyed and ready to take up the task.

May the Blessed Mother (Our Lady of Sorrows), who shared in the sufferings of her Son help us and show us how navigate our own "valleys of tears" with grace, dignity, and hope. Amen.

myParish App: Parishioners are being encouraged to download the myParish app to their phones; this will enable you to receive the weekly bulletin on Friday. Please enter "Holy Family Church Anna's Retreat." We will be decreasing the amount of bulletins being printed.

Holy Water: Parishioners are asked to refrain from using bottles other than holy water bottles to obtain water. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Sick and Shut-Ins: We're in the process of updating the list, and additional information is needed on the status of the parishioners listed in the bulletin. If you're a family member or know of any of the individuals listed, please contact the church office.

Devotional Candles: Effective **Monday, September 1**st, Devotional Candles will be sold at a cost of **\$8.00**. This is mainly due to the company's increase in candle sales and shipping cost. Also, sales will be limited to no more than **five (5)** candles per person.

Parish Information

Sacrament of Infant Baptism: Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and godparents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 whenever a family member or friend is seriously ill or hospitalized.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visits the sick every Friday, please call the office with additional information.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

Sacrament of Marriage: Please make arrangements with the Pastor 6 months before your wedding by calling the church office.

Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are invited to register at the Church Office. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration also helps in providing quick services for the request and proof of miscellaneous church letters for individuals, Baptism, Confirmation, etc.

Cleaning of the Church: The church is cleaned every Friday of the Month at 6:30 p.m. Volunteers are needed and welcomed.


