



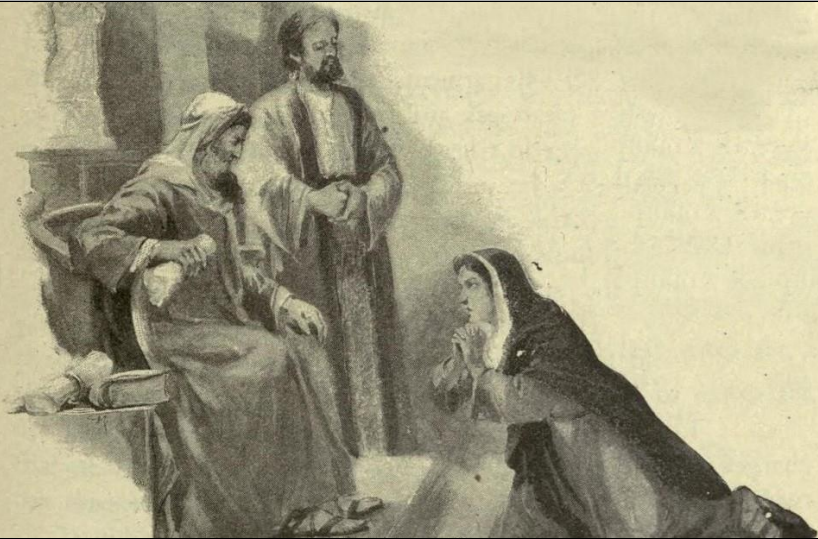

WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Ex 17:8-13

Responsorial Psalm:

Theme: “Persevering prayer”

Brothers and Sisters,

For this 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year C), the Word of God emphasizes the need for persevering prayer and faith, based on the parable of the widow and the unjust judge (Luke 18:1-8). The importance of constant prayer is underlined by the example of Moses supporting his people through prayer, just as believers support one another. The readings encourage us not to be discouraged, to believe in God’s coming justice, and to stand firm in our faith, as St. Paul recommends to Timothy.

We note here the importance of prayer in your life. In the Gospel, Jesus teaches us the story of the widow who begs the unjust judge for justice. This parable shows us that persevering prayer is essential to maintaining our faith and our relationship with God.

Questions for meditation:

- What role does prayer play in my daily life?
- How can I improve my prayer so that it’s more persevering and deeper?
- What obstacles prevent me from praying regularly?

Verse for meditation:

“God will do justice to his chosen ones who cry out to him day and night.” (Luke 18:7)

Objective:

- Deepen your relationship with God through persevering prayer.
- Find strength and consolation in prayer in the face of life’s challenges.
- Become a model of perseverance and faith for others.

Sacrament of Infant Baptism: Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and god-parents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 whenever a family member or friend is seriously ill or hospitalized.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visit the sick every Friday. Please call the office if you have a sick or shut-it that you would like added to the list for home visits.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

Sacrament of Marriage: Please make arrangements with the Pastor 6 months before your wedding by calling the church office.

Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are encouraged to complete a parish registration form. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration helps in providing letters of request for proof of church membership. Also, if you have relocated or your mailing address or contact number has changed, please update it at the church office.

Cleaning of the Church: The church is cleaned every Friday of the Month at 6:30 p.m. Volunteers are needed and welcomed.

Windows: We will soon be installing the vitro symbols for the windows of our church and we will be encouraging each family, person, community, or group of people to donate a window that will cost \$5000. Together let's make our church beautiful.

Catechesis

The importance of prayer in our lives

Prayer invites us to act with courage in the face of a dangerous situation. In today's first reading, we have the example of Moses praying as Joshua engages the Amalekites in battle. Moses said to Joshua: "Go and fight the Amalekites. I will stand on the hilltop with the rod of God in my hand." For both Moses and Joshua, prayer and action go hand in hand.

Prayer is not a waste of time; it's an intelligent way of putting the many activities of our daily lives into perspective.

Prayer is the best way to regain a sense of balance, while maintaining regular contact with God. It reminds us that the Lord accompanies us on our life's pilgrimage. We are never alone in the difficulties we face.

Of all forms of prayer, communal invocation is probably the best and most effective. That's why the Eucharist has always been favoured by Christians. At the Eucharist on the Lord's Day, we come together "in church" to listen to what God has to say, and to receive the Lord's strength. This ecclesial resourcing then allows us to return to our families to face whatever may come our way.

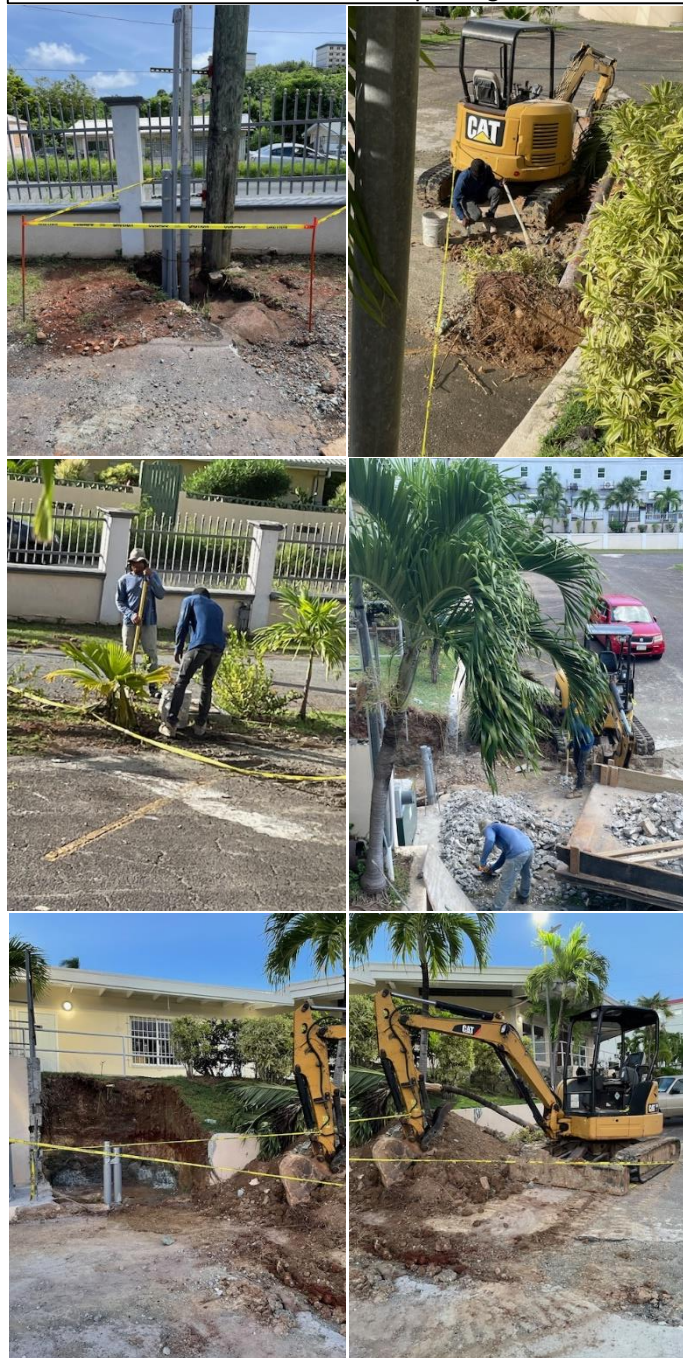

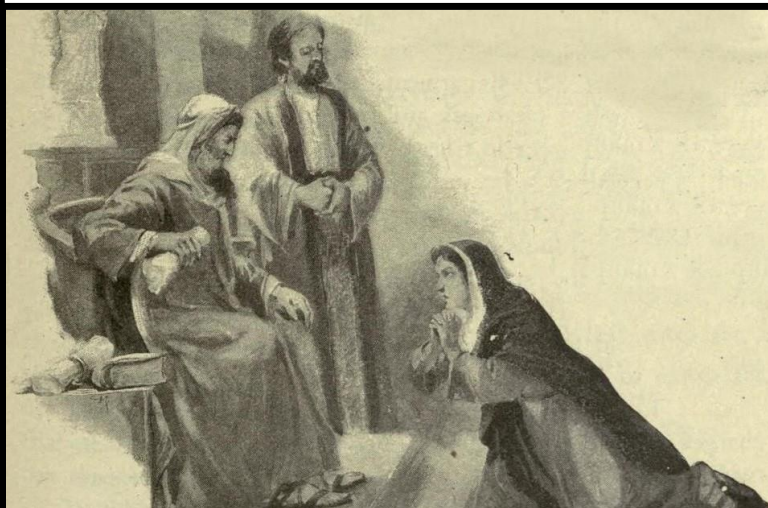
