#### WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Sirach 35:12-14, 16-18

**Responsorial Psalm:** Psalm 34:2-3, 17-18, 19, 23

Second Reading: 2 Timothy 4:6-8, 16-18

**Gospel:** Luke 18:9-14 By Fr Modeste Digwou

Key message: Humility versus pride

Last Sunday, we heard an invitation to pray insistently and with faith. Today, the Word of God reminds us of the inner dispositions we need to have. The gospel presents the attitudes of two categories of people and invites us to identify with them.

- *The Pharisee*: presents himself with his good works and his observance of the law, but his prayer is marked by vanity and contempt for others, especially the publican. He forgets the commandment to love God and neighbor, feeling superior.
- *The publican*: stands at a distance, not even daring to raise his eyes to heaven, and beats his chest, acknowledging his sinful condition. His prayer is simple and sincere: "God, have mercy on me, a sinner!"

#### Jesus' teaching

- *True prayer*: The parable shows that prayer is not a performance or an exercise in merit, but a humble encounter with God.
- *Righteousness comes from God*: Jesus emphasizes that it's not self-justification that counts, but acceptance of God's mercy, which makes righteous those who surrender to him with humility.
- An invitation: This parable is a personal invitation to each of us to ask ourselves what attitude we often hold in our hearts, and to choose the humility of the publican over the self-righteousness of the Pharisee.

### Application for today

- *In our Christian life*: It invites us to examine the way we live, pray and relate to others, so that our actions and words are imbued with love and compassion, rather than a sense of superiority.
- For eternity: Finally, this humility is what will enable us to be with God for eternity, for it is the only thing that remains when all else has passed.

In celebrating this Eucharist, we come to be nourished by the Word of God and his Body. The Lord gives himself to us for our sake, filling us with the strength to proclaim the Gospel. This strength is the grace of Baptism, constantly enlivened by the Eucharist. We pray that all men and women may hear and welcome the Good News you have come to bring to the world.






