Brothers and sisters

This Sunday's main theme of our meditation is ***faith and service***.

Jesus teaches his disciples that faith is not something we have or don't have, but rather an attitude that allows us to trust God and entrust our lives to him.

Jesus uses the image of a servant working for his master to illustrate the attitude we should have towards God. We are called to be faithful servants, working for God with no expectation of reward.

But how can we have this faith and attitude of service? Jesus tells us that even a small amount of faith can accomplish great things. He encourages us to trust in God and entrust our fears and doubts to him.

In conclusion, we are invited this Sunday to reflect on our own faith and attitude towards God. Are we ready to trust God and entrust our lives to him?

Are we ready to be faithful servants, working for God without expecting reward?

Prayer: Lord, give us the faith to trust you with our lives and to be faithful servants. Help us to trust in you and to work for you without expecting reward. Amen.

Parish Information

Sacrament of Infant Baptism: Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and god-parents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 whenever a family member or friend is seriously ill or hospitalized.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visits the sick every Friday, please call the office with additional information.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

Sacrament of Marriage: Please make arrangements with the Pastor 6 months before your wedding by calling the church office.

Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are invited to register at the Church Office. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration also helps in providing quick services for the request and proof of miscellaneous church letters for individuals, Baptism, Confirmation, etc.

Cleaning of the Church: The church is cleaned every Friday of the Month at 6:30 p.m. Volunteers are needed and welcomed.

Catechesis

The month of October is traditionally dedicated to the Rosary in the Catholic Church. Here are a few reasons why:

1. The origin of the rosary: According to Catholic tradition, the rosary was given to Saint Dominic by the Virgin Mary in 1208. The rosary is therefore closely linked to Marian devotion.

2. The month of the Virgin Mary: October is considered to be the month of the Virgin Mary, as it is close to the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, which is celebrated on October 7.

3. Rosary prayer: The Rosary is a prayer that consists of reciting Ave Maria, Pater Noster and Gloria, while meditating on the mysteries of the life of Christ and the Virgin Mary. Rosary prayer is seen as a way of asking for the Virgin Mary's intercession and drawing closer to God.

4. Catholic tradition: Catholic tradition dictates that the faithful pray the rosary during the month of October, particularly on October 7 and 13, which are important days in Marian devotion.
