Meditation for the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica

Today the Church throughout the world celebrates the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome which is the *Cathedral Church of the Pope*, and therefore the mother and head of all churches in the world. At first, it might seem strange: why do we celebrate the anniversary of the dedication of a church building.

The Lateran Basilica was the first Christian church ever built publicly after centuries of persecution. When it was dedicated in the year 324, Christians could finally worship freely. That church became a visible sign of the Church. So, today we remember that we are not just a local parish here in our town or city; we belong to something much greater: the Universal Church, United in faith. Every time we gather for Mass, we are part of that great communion; one family in Christ.

Today's readings remind us that this feast is not just about architecture. In the first reading, the waters flowing from the temple symbolize God's blessing not only for the trees and fishes but for humanity as well. Saint Paul reminds us in the second reading: "You are God's building... you are the temple of God, and the Spirit of God dwells. What a powerful truth! Each of us, through baptism, has become a Dwelling. When we receive the Eucharist, God Himself comes to live within us.

In the Gospel, Jesus drives out the money changers from the temple. He is filled with zeal for His Father's house. This scene challenges us at two levels: first, how do we dress up and how do we conduct ourselves while entering the house of worship? Second, to look inside ourselves: What needs to be cleansed in my heart? Are there attitudes, habits, or distractions that prevent me from being a holy temple for God?

In purifying the temple, Christ wants to do the same with our hearts, to make our hearts places where God truly dwells. This feast also reminds us to appreciate our own parish church. Let us treat this sacred space with love and reverence. We are grateful to all those who work to keep this church clean and beautiful. we implore God's blessings and protection upon you and families.

Catechesis

The Catholic teaching on Purgatory

The month of November is always dedicated to the holy souls in Purgatory. According to the teaching of the church, the faithful are invited to pray novenas, make sacrifices, and request holy Masses for them.

The term "Purge" is understood as a State of purification for souls who die in God's grace and friendship but are still imperfectly purified. Those souls have been blessed to confess their sins and have received the absolution for their sins before departing from this world.

Purgatory is not a place of punishment, but of purification. It's a sign of Christian hope. Those in Purgatory are already saved — their eternal destiny is heaven — but they must be purified of remaining attachments to sin or the temporal effects of sin.

The term "*Purgatory*" does not appear in Scripture, such as the term "*Trinity*". But the reality it refers to is implied by scriptural truths. The doctrine is rooted in biblical principles:

2 Maccabees 12:46 – "It is a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead, that they may be loosed from sins."

1 Corinthians 3:13–15 – St. Paul speaks of a person being saved, "but only as through fire," suggesting a purification after death.

Matthew 12:32 – Jesus mentions that some sins "will not be forgiven, either in this age or in the age to come," implying forgiveness can occur after death. Through indulgences and intercessory prayer, the Church offers spiritual aid to those undergoing purification. We should pray for the dead, whether we haven't experienced the loss of a loved one yet. There is a solidarity between the triumphant church, the militant and the suffering church.
