"Be watchful, for you do not know on what day your Lord will come."

On this first Sunday of Advent, we begin our journey toward Christmas. Everyone is already talking about it with their families, in town, and especially in stores. Every year, we plan big celebrations with family and friends, parties, and gifts. The problem is that many people forget the one who is at the origin of this celebration. It's a bit like celebrating a birthday and completely forgetting the person who is most concerned. We think of everything except him.

This Sunday's three readings therefore point us toward the future. For there is a future for mankind, and God is part of it. He is that future. Far from distracting us from the joyful preparations for Christmas, he reminds us of the seriousness of our daily lives. The real priority is to prepare ourselves every day for the great encounter with the Lord, through a generous and faithful life, filled with trust and love.

"Watch therefore, for you know not what hour your Lord is coming."

On this day, we pray to you, Lord: "Strengthen our steps when the road crosses deserts and swamps. In the effort of the climb, give us a foretaste of the joy of the summits." Amen.

Sacrament of Infant Baptism: Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and god-parents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 whenever a family member or friend is seriously ill or hospitalized.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visit the sick every Friday. Please call the office if you have a sick or shut-it that you would like added to the list for home visits.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

Sacrament of Marriage: Please make arrangements with the Pastor 6 months before your wedding by calling the church office.

Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are encouraged to complete a parish registration form. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration helps in providing letters of request for proof of church membership. Also, if you have relocated of your mailing address or contact number has changed, please update it at the church office.

Catechesis

Advent catechesis: What should we remember?

Advent is a four-week liturgical season that invites us to prepare our hearts, to experience inner joy, and to turn to Christ, the Light of the world. It helps us to experience the mysteries of God's salvation in the incarnation of his Son, who became flesh in the womb of the Virgin Mary and made his home among us. Sunday after Sunday, we will meditate on the texts of the prophet Isaiah and the Gospel according to Saint Matthew, with John the Baptist, the precursor, and the Virgin Mary as the central characters.

Practical activities, such as making an Advent wreath, can symbolize this waiting and become moments of family sharing. Another activity is building a Christmas crib, which dates back to St. Francis of Assisi.

Central themes of catechesis during Advent

- Waiting and patience: In contrast to the immediacy of our times, Advent is a time of patience, reminding us that waiting is a virtue. It is preparing for the arrival of a great joy, that of the birth of Jesus.
- Hope: Advent recalls the hope of the people of Israel who waited for centuries for the coming of a Savior, which was fulfilled in Jesus. It is a hope that helps us to move forward, even in difficult times.
- Preparation of the heart: This is an inner preparation to welcome Jesus into our lives. It is done through prayer, meditation, and listening to the Word of God.
- Joy and light: Advent is also a time of inner joy. The symbol of the candle on the Advent wreath represents this light that grows and dispels darkness, echoing the prophecies of Isaiah.
- The model of Mary: The Virgin Mary is the model of this joyful and confident expectation.






