WEEKLY REFLECTION

Let us go forth to meet God,

On this fourth Sunday of Advent, the liturgy offers us two accounts of the Annunciation. In the first reading, the young king of Israel did not make the right choice. He abandoned the true God to turn to pagan gods and win their favor.

This is also true for us today. We think of those gods that occupy a large place in our lives and our world: they are called money, riches, the pursuit of profit, a good position... Today, the prophet Isaiah invites King Ahaz and each one of us to turn to the one true God. During this season of Advent, we are invited to rediscover the true meaning of Christmas.

In this Sunday's Gospel, we hear the angel's message to Joseph: he is invited to take Mary, his wife, into his home: "The child conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit."

These words tell us the mission that God entrusts to Joseph: he is called to be the guardian of Mary and Jesus; Joseph exercises this guardianship with discretion and humility, in silence.

Joseph is therefore the guardian of Mary, Jesus, and the whole Church. All this was made possible only because of his constant attention to God. Joseph is the guardian because he knows how to listen to God, allowing himself to be guided by His will, he is attentive to his surroundings; he knows how to make the wisest decisions. Like him, we are all called to keep Christ at the center of our lives.

We can only experience a true Christmas if we take Mary, our Mother, into our homes. With her, we welcome Jesus, who came to seek and save those who were lost.

Sacrament of Infant Baptism: Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and god-parents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 whenever a family member or friend is seriously ill or hospitalized.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visit the sick every Friday. Please call the office if you have a sick or shut-it that you would like added to the list for home visits.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

Sacrament of Marriage: Please make arrangements with the Pastor 6 months before your wedding by calling the church office.

Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are encouraged to complete a parish registration form. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration helps in providing letters of request for proof of church membership. Also, if you have relocated of your mailing address or contact number has changed, please update it at the church office.

Cleaning of the Church: The church is cleaned every Friday of the Month at 6:30 p.m. Volunteers are needed and welcomed.

Catechesis

Summary of Pope Leo XIV's message for Christmas 2025

For Christmas 2025, Pope Leo XIV, in his Advent messages, emphasizes peace, hope, and reconciliation, inviting the faithful to be "witnesses of hope" by seeking Christ in daily life, and recalling the importance of silence, humility (like the manger in Bethlehem), and solidarity, especially toward the most disadvantaged and prisoners, while celebrating the Jubilee of Hope.

· Hope in the face of trials

- o The pope encourages us to be attentive to the signs of Christ's coming and not to remain passive, but to participate actively in hope.
- o He emphasizes that Jesus' resurrection is the light that illuminates the mystery of death and prepares us for eternal life.

For the Pope

- o "Peace, peace must guide the destiny of peoples and of all humanity!"
- o He invites us to rediscover Mary's contemplative silence, keeping the mysteries in her heart, in the face of the humility of the manger. Hence Silence and Adoration
- o "Let no one be lost! Let everyone be saved!" He calls for a "civilization of love," focusing on prisoners and the excluded, advocating reconciliation and dignity. This is an invitation to live Justice and Charity.
- He entrusts to the laity the mission of being witnesses of hope by recognizing God's presence in the world.
- o His messages are set in the post-Jubilee context, reminding the faithful to continue to live out the fruits of this holy year.




