WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Isaiah 49:3, 5-6

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 40:2, 4, 7-8, 8-9, 10

Beloved brothers and sisters in Christ, we have come to the second Sunday in ordinary time in the cycle year A. Last Sunday, we ended the Christmas season with the Feast of the Baptism of our Blessed Lord Jesus Christ, which was another epiphany of the Lord, in whom the Father was well pleased. Also, last Sunday was the beginning of the Ordinary time, time of discipleship, time of following the Lord more closely.

Today's Gospel highlights a profound phrase uttered by every priest, that we always hear at Mass after consecration: "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world." These words of John the Baptist are not only an introduction to Jesus' public ministry; they are a revelation of who Jesus is and what He has come to do.

In this statement, the Baptizer is pointing us the Lamb of God, the unblemished Lamb of God. He is inviting us to focus on Him, not anything else nor anyone else. It's a call to attentiveness, less anything else distract us on our journey to where and to whom we belong, God and heaven. The ordinary time in the church is a call to discipleship. It's a call to first recognize who Jesus Christ really is, and what he has come to do on earth.

So often, we look everywhere else for meaning such as success, power, and pleasure at all costs, we look for identity, and yet we fail to truly behold Christ. We fail to see Christ is the answer or the purpose of our searches. John teaches us that faith begins with recognition. Faith is about a person, the person of Christ which is the ultimate revelation of God the Father. Faith is not an ideology, it's a life lived by Christ on earth.

Why did Christ come to earth for? Christ came to take away the sin of the world. It means that sin is real. Ignoring sin is ignoring Christ's mission here and now. Ignoring sin (in all its forms) is ignoring the fight against sin we should all be enrolled in. Christ conquers sin by self-giving love. He does not ignore sin, excuse it, or crush the sinner. He takes it upon Himself. Jesus enters the brokenness of the world not to condemn it, but to redeem it. Every time we feel trapped by guilt, weakness, or failure, the Lamb of God stands before us saying, "I have come for this, you cannot fix it by yourself, and you aren't alone in this." May the Blessed Mary, who was the first disciple to follow the promptings of her son assist us in our daily discipleship. Amen.

Sacrament of Infant Baptism: Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and god-parents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 whenever a family member or friend is seriously ill or hospitalized.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

Sacrament of Marriage: Please make arrangements with the Pastor 6 months before your wedding by calling the church office.

Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are encouraged to complete a parish registration form. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration helps in providing letters of request for proof of church membership. Also, if you have relocated or your mailing address or contact number has changed, please update it at the church office.

Cleaning of the Church: The church is cleaned every Friday of the Month at 6:30 p.m. Volunteers are needed and welcomed.

Catechesis

Last weekend, we have begun a spiritual journey by rediscovering the profound meaning of the Decalogue. We emphasized on the first commandment. Today we continue with the theological virtues namely Faith, Hope and Charity which are part of the first commandment and eventually we are going to focus on the second commandment.

Sins against faith: willful doubt of any article of faith; deliberate ignorance of the truths of faith which ought to be known, neglect of instructing oneself in the faith according to one's state of life;

Apostasy (rebellion and spiritual infidelity from core Christian truths and morality); Heresy (a damaging division or teaching that fundamentally contradicts core Christian doctrine, threatening salvation by distorting the truth about God, Jesus Christ or the Gospel)

Reading or circulating books or writings against the Catholic belief; to remain silent when asked about one's faith; engaging in schismatic or heretical worship; joining or supporting masonic groups or others forbidden societies.

Sins against Hope: despair of God's mercy, presumption (to hope for salvation without conversion, or hope to obtain heavenly glory without merit); presuming on God's mercy or on the supposed efficacy of certain pious practices, in order to continue in sin; refusing any dependence on God.

Sins against Charity: not making an act of charity regularly during life especially during times of necessity; egoism (one cares only about himself, praises himself, selfish, enjoys receiving praise); ingratitude (fails to or refuse to acknowledge divine charity and to return His love for love; lukewarmness (hesitation or negligence in responding to divine love; it can imply refusal to give oneself over to the prompting of charity).






