





WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Zephaniah 2:3; 3:12-13

Brothers and sisters in Christ,

On this 4th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year A), the Gospel focuses on the Beatitudes (Mt 5:1-12a), true paths to happiness that reverse the logic of the world. Jesus invites us to poverty of heart, gentleness, justice, and peace, promising that God is close to the humble, the persecuted, and those who suffer. It is a call to be witnesses of Christ's joy and light.

- **According to Jesus, happiness** does not lie in wealth or power, but in welcoming God, even in times of trial. The Beatitudes are a “roadmap” for becoming like Christ.
- **The “poor in spirit”:** This means recognizing that we are small and dependent on God, not relying on ourselves.
- **Counterculture:** The Beatitudes are opposed to the spirit of the world, offering a perspective on life centered on love, justice, and peace.
- **Witnesses in the world:** The faithful are sent out as “lighted lamps” to spread this good news, especially to those who are wounded by life. Meditation invites us to ask for the grace of humility and courage to follow Jesus on this path of happiness, even in the face of misunderstanding.

We are invited to listen to the voice of the Lord and not to close our hearts, but rather to let them be plowed by God to become good soil ready to receive the Word.

Through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, let us ask the Lord to always help us discern where our true happiness lies. May He grant us the understanding that we can find it in Him, even when the world would have us believe that all is lost. Praised be Jesus Christ!

Parish Information

Sacrament of Infant Baptism: Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and god-parents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 whenever a family member or friend is seriously ill or hospitalized.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm (**temporarily moved to Thursday**).

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visit the sick every Friday. Please call the office if you have a sick or shut-in that you would like added to the list for home visits.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

Sacrament of Marriage: Please make arrangements with the Pastor 6 months before your wedding by calling the church office.

Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are encouraged to complete a parish registration form. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration helps in providing letters of request for proof of church membership. Also, if you have relocated or your mailing address or contact number has changed, please update it at the church office.

Cleaning of the Church: The church is cleaned every Friday of the Month at 6:30 p.m. Volunteers are needed and welcomed.

Catechesis

The Second Commandment (continued)

The second commandment is as follows: **You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain; for the Lord will not hold him guiltless who takes His name in vain (Exodus 20:7).** This means that we should not use God's name incorrectly or inappropriately. Some people use God's name as a swear word, an exclamation of fear or surprise. This is one way in which God's name is used inappropriately. Most Christians would not say or use God's name in this way.

False prophecies

Another possibility is when people say "God says..." to perhaps add weight to what they are saying or to force others to obey their words. Unfortunately, sometimes Christians abuse God's name in this way. Saying these words lightly, or when God has not spoken, is something that God hates. In the Old Testament, He used His true prophets to denounce false prophets who claimed that God had spoken when He had not. Jeremiah 23:25, Ezekiel 22:28, Deuteronomy 13:2. False prophets were to be put to death.

Nowadays, there are many people who try to persuade others that God has spoken through them, when He has not spoken at all. Although they are not punished with death here on earth, God says that He will not hold them blameless. For Christians, when we know, love, and honor God, it is unlikely that we will take the name of the Lord our God in vain, but we must be careful in the words we speak.

God does speak to us, and He may well give us a message to give to someone else. But make sure that it is truly the Holy Spirit who has put these things in your heart. Otherwise, we may also find that we are taking God's name in vain, using it inappropriately for our own purposes instead of glorifying God. We should always revere and glorify His name before Him and before the world.






