### WEEKLY REFLECTION

Dear brethren, since the beginning of Lent now we have prepared our hearts, by penance and charitable works. Today, we gather together to herald with the whole Church the beginning of the celebration of our Lord's Pascal Mystery, that is to say, of his Passion and Resurrection. For it was to accomplish this mystery that he entered, in his own city of Jerusalem. *Cf Roman Missal*

In the Passion narrative, we have the impression that we are at the theater hall, where people play various roles. In reality, it was not a whole play. The people mentioned were honest and true to everything, they said and did. They were not joking. Each of these people holds up a mirror. Somewhere in that story, we find ourselves.

Palm Sunday confronts us with a hard truth: human hearts can be unpredictable, even contradictory. Moreover, that includes our own. We, too, welcome Jesus when it is easy, especially when faith feels good, when prayers are answered, when life is going well. We wave our palms. We sing our songs. However, what about when following Christ become challenging? When it costs us something? Do we not begin to turn away from Him?

In the midst of this dramatic story, we can experience human inconsistency in opposition to Christ faithfulness. While everything around Him collapses such as friendship, justice, loyalty, the Lord Jesus remains steadfast. He does not turn back. He does not abandon His mission. He embraces the Cross freely, without being pressured not because He loves suffering but because He loves us.

As we begin this sacred week, let us make ourselves available to God's grace, not just to praise our Lord when it is easy, but also to follow Him when it is hard. Not just to walk in the procession, but to walk all the way to the cross, because we know that beyond the cross is the empty tomb. May our Lady of Sorrows walks with us in our times of uncertainties as she did with her Son. Amen.

# Parish Information

**The Sacrament of Infant Baptism:** Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and god-parents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes:** RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

**CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation:** CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

**Sacrament of Penance:** Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

**Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick:** Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 whenever a family member or friend is seriously ill or hospitalized.

**Healing Mass:** A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm.

**Visiting the Sick:** The parish priests visit the sick every Friday. Please call the office if you have a sick or shut-it that you would like added to the list for home visits.

**Funerals:** All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

**The Sacrament of Holy Matrimony:** Please make arrangements with the Pastor 6 months before your wedding by calling the church office.

**Parish Registration:** Parishioners who are 18 years and older are encouraged to complete a parish registration form. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration helps in providing letters of request for proof of church membership. # Catechesis

## The Precepts of the Church

Besides the Ten Commandments of God, the faithful are also bound to follow the precepts of the church. The power for making these laws comes from Jesus Christ, and includes everything necessary for the government of the Church and for the direction of the faithful in order that they may attain their eternal salvation.

- **First precepts: To assist at holy Mass on all Sundays and holy days of obligation (6)** (CIC: Christmas Day (Dec 25); Motherhood of Mary (Jan 1); Ascension Thursday (40 days after Easter); Assumption (August 15); All Saints Day (Nov. 1); Immaculate Conception (Dec. 8). The Church obliges us to abstain from servile work on Holy Days of obligation.
- **Second precept: To fast, abstain and do penance on prescribed days.** The law of fasting binds those who have attained their age of majority (18), until the beginning of their 60<sup>th</sup>. Fasting means to eat less food than one normally eats. On days of fasting, we are allowed only one full meal and two small meals, which together are less than one full meal; days of fasting are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On days of abstinence, we are forbidden to eat flesh-meat. Days of abstinence are all of the Fridays of the year.
- **Third precept: To confess our mortal sins at least once a year.** The Church urges us to go the great Sacrament of Confession frequently, but only actually commands us to go at least once a year in order to warn those people who have presumption on the mercy of God, which is a sin against the Holy Spirit. The obligation to confess once a year is only binding on those who have committed a mortal sin and have not confessed for at least one year.
- **Fourth precept: To receive Holy Communion during Easter season.** The Easter season begins on the First Sunday of Lent and ends on Trinity Sunday. After receiving our First Holy Communion, it is strongly recommended to receive this great Sacrament frequently during our lifetime.
- **Fifth precept: Contribute to the support of your Pastor.** This precept requires each to provide for the material needs of the Church according to his means.


