



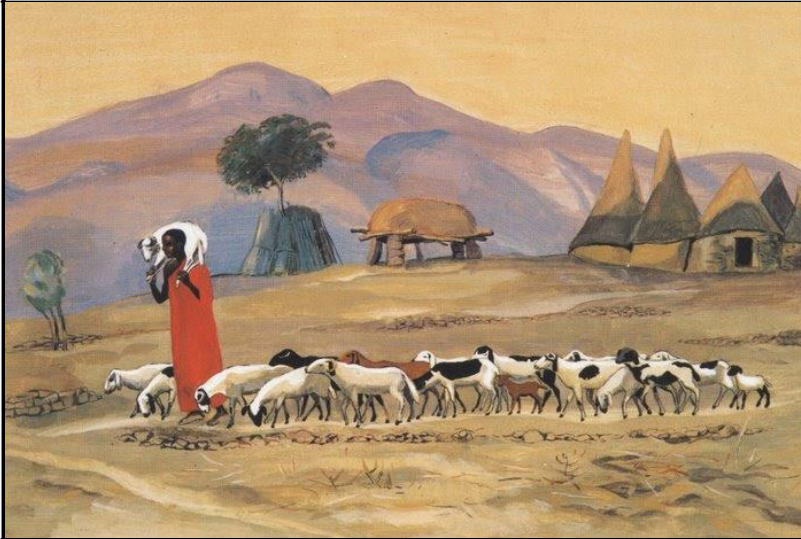

WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Acts 2:14a, 36-41

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 23:1-3a, 3b4, 5, 6

Gospel: John 10:1-10

Brothers and Sisters,

The 4th Sunday of Easter (Year A) is the Sunday of the Good Shepherd and the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. Based on John 10:1-10, the gospel emphasizes Jesus as the “door of the sheep,” the only way to salvation and life in abundance. He is the shepherd who personally calls and protects, inviting us to follow him.

Jesus, the Door and the Shepherd: Unlike the thief, Jesus enters through the door, knows his sheep by name and leads them. He defines himself as the real shepherd who gives his life for his sheep.

- Life in Abundance: Jesus’ goal is to offer a life “in abundance,” an eternal life and not just a simple survival.
- Listen and Follow: The relationship with the Good Shepherd requires listening to his voice and following him, which implies going through the “door” that he is, abandoning the false ways.
- Day of Vocations: This Sunday highlights God’s call to holiness for all, and specifically the call to serve him as priests, religious or nuns.

We are lucky to have a “DOOR” to go to God like the one that is Jesus. We can be sure of his constant presence in our lives even when we don’t feel it. Let’s give our thanksgiving for this gift from God.

These criteria are used to verify parishioners' status for sponsor verification, participation in sacramental, pastoral, and social ministries.

Office Closure: The church office will be closed on **Friday, May 1st from 9:00 am to 12 noon**, and **all day on Saturday, May 2nd**. Please be guided accordingly.

Parish Information

Sacrament of Baptism (Infant): Our Baptisms are celebrated on the **fourth Sunday** of every month. Parents and godparents are **required** to attend **two (2)** preparation classes. Registration forms are available in the church office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 anytime for an anointing of the sick and dying. The priests visit our sick and shut-ins **every Friday with Holy Communion**.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm at the Shrine.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visit the sick every Friday. Please call the office if you have a sick or shut-it that you would like added to the list for home visits.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

The Sacrament of Matrimony: Please contact the priest **six (6) months** prior to the date of the intended wedding. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans. **Marriage preparation is mandatory.**

Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are encouraged to complete a parish registration form. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration helps in providing letters of request for proof of church membership. Also, if you have relocated or your mailing address or contact number has changed, please update it at the church office.

Church Cleaning: The church is cleaned every Friday of the Month at 6:30 p.m. Volunteers are needed and welcomed.

Gratitude: We have been receiving Offertory envelopes from our homebound parishioners. We thank you for keeping up with your sacrificial commitment. We also extend our thanks to our online contributors. May God reward your generosity.

Catechesis

Spirituality

Five ways to fully experience the joy of Discover some ideas to fully experience the joy of the Resurrection during these fifty days of Easter time, and even beyond. During Lent, Christians fervently devote themselves to prayer, fasting and sacrifice, offering everything to Christ in response to his love. However, once Easter Sunday arrives, many do not always know how to live the joy that follows. The risk then is to consider the Resurrection as a one-off event, rather than to recognize it as a living and still acting reality today. Christ is risen and continues to renew everything. Through His Resurrection, Christ invites everyone to lay their faults in the tomb and to enter the new life with Him. Jesus fulfills the word that is said in the book of Revelation: “Behold, I do all new things” (Rev 21,5). Easter time – those fifty bright days that separate Easter from Pentecost – is a time to rise with the Lord and let ourselves be deeply renewed by Him. So how can you truly meet the risen Christ and let yourself be transformed by his grace?

1. Immerse yourself in the Acts of the Apostles.

In the Acts of the Apostles, it is possible to see how the first disciples, filled with the Holy Spirit, passed from fear to bold testimony. If their life has been radically transformed by the Resurrection, yours can also be. May their example inspire everyone to live with the same spiritual strength!

2. Make the Resurrection a turning point.

The Resurrection has not only changed history; it can change yours. Every morning, you can think of three situations in your life where you feel blocked or defeated. Entrust all this to the risen Lord and say

with faith: “Since Christ is risen, he can overcome these difficulties.” May this time be that of an inner renewal!

3. Meet Christ through others.

Each person you meet carries within them the imprint of the Resurrection. Try to look at everyone with a renewed look, even those with whom you have relationship difficulties: show Mercy, listen to them with kindness, offer them your kindness and look for how Christ acts in them too.

4. Rediscover your unique mission.

The first Christians had the urgent mission of proclaiming the Resurrection to the world. Even today, everyone has a special vocation to make known the victory of Christ. Put your passions and talents at the service of faith: if you like to write, proclaim the Gospel by writing articles or books, if you like to sing, offer your help to the parish for the animation of the Mass, if you like to teach children, give your time for catechism... Make what you love a bridge that leads others to the Risen One.

5. Discover a spiritual devotion.

The Church is rich in traditions that bring God closer. Why not integrate a new practice during this Easter time? Pray the rosary, wear a scapular or a miraculous medal, get into the habit of praying for the deceased when going to the cemetery...

These simple practices are powerful channels of grace that allow you to deepen your life of faith and be renewed. Whatever your choice, approach the coming weeks as if you were hearing the Good News of the Resurrection for the very first time. Let the risen Christ surprise you and transform you. He calls you, not only to believe in His Resurrection, but to rise with Him, spreading his light and joy in all aspects of your life..

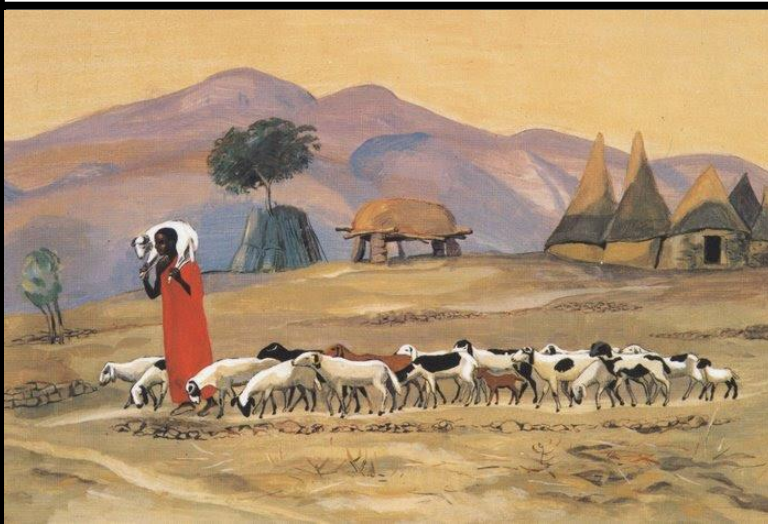

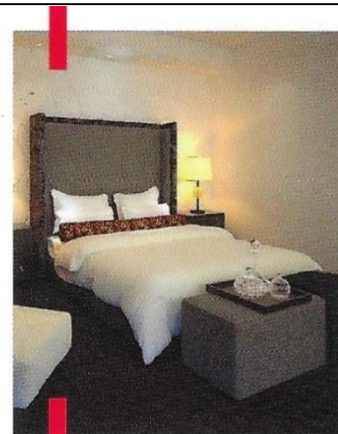
