WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Acts 10:34a, 37-43

Responsorial Psalm:

Psalm 118:1-2, 16-17, 22-23

Second Reading: Colossians 3:1-4

Gospel: John 20:1-9

Brothers and Sisters Today, of course, is the most important day for us in the year. It is the celebration of the rising of Jesus from the dead. It is the beginning of a whole new way of looking at life and we, as Christians, look upon life no longer through our eyes, but through the eyes of the One who broke through the terror of death and into a new way of being. In brief, Easter Sunday (Year A) celebrates Jesus' resurrection as God's definitive victory over sin and death, transforming despair into hope. Matthew's Gospel, encourages us to stop standing at the empty tomb and instead become witnesses, bringing light to a world filled with darkness.

- Mary Magdalene, Peter, and the beloved disciple encounter an empty tomb, challenging them to move from confusion to believing that Jesus has risen (John 20:1-9). Easter is not a "standing still" faith but a running faith; we are called to bring the good news to the world.
- As Acts 10:34-43 highlights, we are called to be witnesses to the resurrection. This means becoming "Resurrection people"—living in joy, hope, and love, rather than in the tombs of doubt, fear, or addiction. (First Reading)
- Easter assures us that God can turn our worst moments—failure, suffering, and death—into new beginnings. It allows us to face the unpredictable world with courage, knowing that God's love has the final word. (2nd Reading)
- We must look for Jesus not in the "world of the dead" (empty rituals or indifference), but in the world of the living—where love, justice, and compassion are active. (Gospel)
- The Resurrected Lord dwells in our neighbors, prompting us to offer humble, selfless service. We are urged to choose love over indifference and hope over fear in our daily lives.

The Sacrament of Infant Baptism: Infant Baptisms will take place on the **Fourth Sunday** of every month, parents and god-parents must attend two pre-baptismal classes prior to the Baptism. Please register your child.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 whenever a family member or friend is seriously ill or hospitalized.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visit the sick every Friday. Please call the office if you have a sick or shut-it that you would like added to the list for home visits.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

Catechesis

Divine Mercy Sunday



After Easter, We celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. What is it and what are his components Divine Mercy is a Catholic devotion centering on God's infinite love, compassion, and desire to forgive even the gravest sins, primarily revealed through St. Faustina Kowalski (a Polish nun who received revelations from Jesus in the 1930s). It emphasizes trusting in Jesus, asking for mercy, and being merciful to others. Key elements include the Divine Mercy Image, the Chaplet, and Divine Mercy Sunday. Core Components of the Devotion:

- The Image of Divine Mercy: Based on a 1931 vision, it shows Jesus with his right hand raised in blessing and his left touching his chest, from which flow red and pale rays representing blood (life of souls) and water (justification). It typically bears the signature "Jesus, I trust in You."
- The Chaplet of Divine Mercy: A prayer for mercy, often said on rosary beads, which begins with a simple, powerful prayer: "Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and the Blood, Soul and Divinity of your dearly beloved Son, our Lord Jesus Christ in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world."
- Divine Mercy Sunday: Celebrated the Sunday after Easter, Jesus promised that those who go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on this day will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. Pope St. John Paul II officially established the feast for the universal Church on April 30, 2000, which was the canonization date of St. Faustina
- The Hour of Great Mercy: 3:00 PM, the time of Christ's death, is observed with prayer.

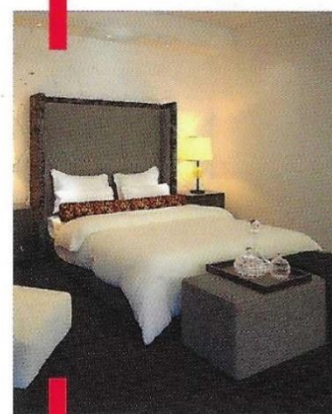
