Reflection on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

A quick look at the readings for today shows very clearly that the Feast of the Trinity is a celebration of God's love for humankind. It is a day for reflecting on who God is, not for trying to figure out how there can be three persons in one God. The Church's focus today is on experience, not theology.

In intellectual terms, God remains a mystery. For people of faith, God is known not by the mind, but by the heart. That is what spirituality and mysticism are about – exploring our experience of God.

In the first reading God is proclaimed as a God of tenderness and compassion, slow to anger and rich in mercy; a God who walks with his people. Paul's words in the second reading are born out of his belief that, having been made in the image and likeness of God, Christians must always act in the image and likeness of God.

Through our public liturgy, private prayer and contemplation we come to experience – to 'know' and feel in our hearts – that God loves us, accepts us, forgives us and constantly invites us into an ever deeper experience of love.

When we allow God's heart to speak to ours in love, we begin to absorb more of God's life into our own. We are being transformed. Our values and attitudes, our ways of looking at and being in the world start to change. We begin to see with God's eyes and feel with God's heart.

We become passionate about the things God is passionate about: speaking truthfully, acting with justice and integrity, looking out for each other and especially for the vulnerable, promoting peace and understanding, ending competition and discrimination, respecting life.

That makes us better people and our lives become a blessing for each other and for the world. That is what it means to live out of God's great gift to us, the Spirit of Jesus Christ which God has placed in our hearts. God becomes enfleshed in us and we become stewards of God's grace and life.

Sacrament of Baptism (Infant): Our Baptisms are celebrated on the **fourth Sunday** of every month. Parents and godparents **are required** to attend **two (2)** preparation classes. Registration forms are available in the church office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 anytime for an anointing of the sick and dying. The priests visit our sick and shut-ins **every Friday with Holy Communion**.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm at the Shrine.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visit the sick **every Friday**. Please call the office if you have a sick or shut-it that you would like added to the list for home visits.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

The Sacrament of Matrimony: Please contact the priest **six (6) months** prior to the date of the intended wedding. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans. **Marriage preparation is mandatory.**

Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are encouraged to complete a parish registration form. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration helps in providing letters of request for proof of church membership. Also, if you have relocated or your mailing address or contact number has changed, please update it at the church office.

Catechesis

Apostolic Exhortation Dilexi Te

Pope Leo XIV's *Dilexi Te* ("I Have Loved You") was his first **apostolic exhortation**, released in October 2025. It focuses on the Christian duty to love and serve the poor, presenting care for the vulnerable as central to the Gospel rather than optional charity. This theme matches with the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity we celebrate today. The document argues that the love of Christ cannot be separated from love for the poor, poverty is not only material but also social and spiritual exclusion, and Christians must recognize Christ present in suffering people. The exhortation is divided into four main themes.

1. The poor are at the center of the Gospel

Leo XIV says the Church must have a "preferential option for the poor," continuing a major theme of Catholic social teaching and the pontificate of Pope Francis. He insists: faith without concern for the poor becomes empty, Christians cannot separate worship from justice, and the Church must resist indifference and elitism.

2. Criticism of inequality and exclusion

The exhortation criticizes extreme economic inequality, societies built around consumerism, neglect of migrants and refugees, and systems that isolate the vulnerable. Leo XIV warns against what he calls a "culture of fear" toward migrants and marginalized people.

3. Continuity with Pope Francis message.

A major feature of *Dilexi Te* is that parts were reportedly drafted by Pope Francis before his death, and then completed by Leo XIV. The document strongly reflects Francis' themes, which are mercy, solidarity, the dignity of migrants, critique of a "throwaway culture," and the Church as a "Church of the poor."

4. Charity and human dignity

Leo XIV emphasizes that helping the poor is not only about material aid but also about restoring dignity such as meaningful work, education, inclusion, accompaniment, and human relationships. He argues Christians should avoid treating the poor as problems to manage and instead encounter them personally. It calls Catholics to conversion of heart and renewed compassion.

Catholic Charities of the VI help the underserved. Gently used clothing, furniture, or mobility aids are always appreciated, as are in-kind services, food products, including vegetables, utilizing our barrel at The Market in Tutu Park Mall.

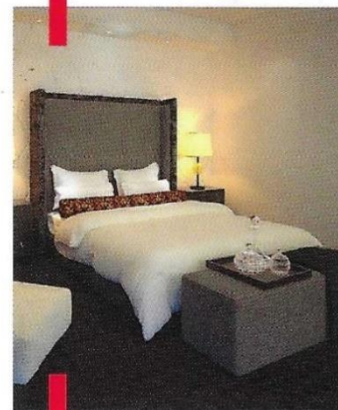
