WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Exodus 19:2-6a

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 100:1-2, 3, 5

Second Reading: Romans 5:6-11

Gospel: Matthew 9:36–10:8

Brothers and sisters,

The readings for this Sunday take us to the very heart of our Christian vocation. The Gospel begins with a glance. Jesus does not look down on the crowd with indifference. He looks at them with deep compassion. He is “moved with compassion.” He sees men and women who are “weary and downcast, like sheep without a shepherd.”

We could make this observation our own today. When we open the newspapers, observe our society, or look at those around us, we see so many people searching for meaning, sometimes exhausted by trials, wounded by divisions or discouragement. Faced with this distress, our first instinct might be to give up or feel sorry for ourselves.

But Jesus reacts quite differently. He tells us: ***“The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest.”***

1. The Lord of the harvest is He. The first good news is that we are not the saviors of the world. Salvation comes from God. The harvest belongs to Him. Our role is not to carry the world on our shoulders by our own strength, but to recognize that the Lord is already at work. The world thirsts for hope, and God wants to satisfy that thirst.

2. A Personal and Concrete Call. The second step is decisive: after inviting them to pray, Jesus calls his disciples by name. He does not choose them from among perfect people, but from among ordinary men, with their limitations. He gathers them together and gives them a specific mission: “Go... heal, cleanse, raise the dead, cast out demons.”

Today, this call resounds for each of us. Through our baptism, we are all “workers sent on a mission.” The Lord does not ask us to perform extraordinary feats or to convert the whole world in a single day. He asks us to be witnesses to his mercy where we live: in our families, at our workplaces, in our neighborhoods.

3. Hands Reached Out to Reconcile. The second reading, from Saint Paul’s Letter to the Romans, gives us the strength to fulfill this mission. It reminds us that “Christ died for us while we were still sinners.” We are sent not to judge, but to share this unconditional love.

To be workers today is to reach out to those who have fallen, to listen to those who feel alone, and to bring a little gentleness and peace where there is tension.

As we celebrate this Eucharist, let us give thanks for the call the Lord has extended to us. Let us ask him to give us eyes capable of seeing the distress around us, and a heart overflowing with his compassion to respond to it with joy.

Amen.

Parish Information

Sacrament of Baptism (Infant): Our Baptisms are celebrated on the **fourth Sunday** of every month. Parents and godparents **are required** to attend **two (2)** preparation classes. Registration forms are available in the church office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 anytime for an anointing of the sick and dying. The priests visit our sick and shut-ins **every Friday with Holy Communion**.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm at the Shrine.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visit the sick **every Friday**. Please call the office if you have a sick or shut-it that you would like added to the list for home visits.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

The Sacrament of Matrimony: Please contact the priest **six (6) months** prior to the date of the intended wedding. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans. **Marriage preparation is mandatory.**

Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are encouraged to complete a parish registration form. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration helps in providing letters of request for proof of church membership. Also, if you have relocated or your mailing address or contact number has changed, please update it at the church office.

Church Cleaning: The church is cleaned every Friday of the Month at 6:30 p.m. Volunteers are needed and welcomed.

Special Collection: A special collection will be taken up for the air conditioning project **next weekend** at all Masses. Thank you for your generosity.

Catechesis

Liturgical Signs and Gestures

Many Catholics love Holy Mass...
but no one has ever explained to them what is really
happening before their eyes.

And when one discovers the meaning of these small
gestures... the liturgy is transformed forever.

The sign of the cross at the beginning.

It is not merely a habitual gesture.

It is a spiritual declaration.

We begin Mass by entering in the name of the Father, the
Son, and the Holy Spirit. We remember our baptism and
proclaim our belonging to Christ.

The incense.

The rising smoke represents prayer ascending to God. It
also honors the divine presence on the altar, in the Gospel,
and in the Eucharist.

Nothing in the liturgy is merely ornamental.

Standing for the Gospel.

Why don't we remain seated?

Because Christ himself speaks in the Gospel. The Church
stands as a people attentive before their King.

The gentle touch on the chest before receiving Communion.

"Lord, I am not worthy..."

This is humility.

It is recognizing that no one deserves the Eucharist by their
own strength.

Communion is not a reward for the perfect.

It is the food of repentant sinners.

The silence after receiving Communion.

Many people, after receiving Communion, look around or
think about leaving.

But you have just received the living Christ himself.

This silence is one of the most intimate moments of the
entire Mass.

Heaven touches earth... and the soul converses with God.

The Catholic liturgy is rich in symbols because God knows
that human beings also learn through their senses.

That is why Mass is not simply a matter of "attending."

It is entering into an eternal mystery that the Church has
preserved for centuries.

*And the more one understands the liturgy... the more
impossible it becomes to experience it with indifference.*

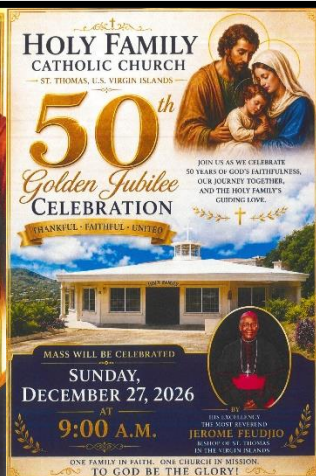
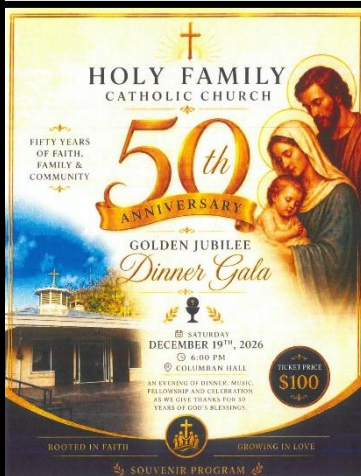

Lekti pou dimanch sa a mennen nou nan kè vokasyon kretyen nou an. Levanjil la kòmanse ak yon ti koutje sou. Jezi pa gade foul la avèk endiferans. Li gade yo avèk yon gwo konpasyon. Li “gen konpasyon.” Li wè gason ak fanm ki “fatige e ki dekouraje, tankou mouton ki san gadò.”

Nou te ka fè obsèvasyon sa a vin pa nou jodi a. Lè nou ouvri jounal yo, obsève sosyete nou an, oswa gade moun ki bò kote nou yo, nou wè anpil moun k ap chèche sans, pafwa fatigue pa eprè, blese pa divizyon oswa dekourajman. 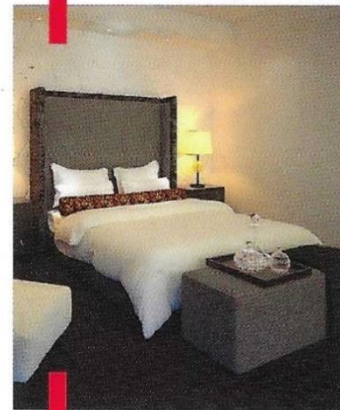
