



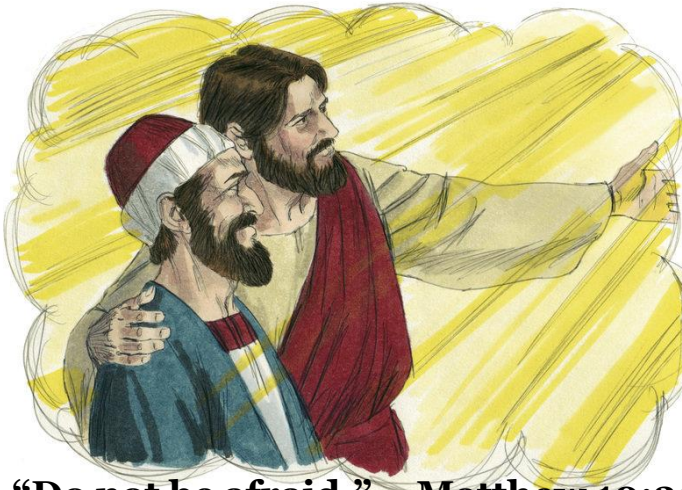

WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Jeremiah 20:10-13

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 69:8-10, 14, 17, 33-35

Second Reading: Romans 5:12-15

Gospel: Matthew 10:26-33

Brother and sisters,

The Same Cry Echoing Through the Centuries: One of the great figures among the righteous who were persecuted in the Old Testament is Jeremiah. Rejected just as Jesus would be, he laments but remains trusting in God. In this passage from Jer 20, the prophet is on the brink of despair: he hears the slander, and even his own friends are watching for his missteps. Yet, in the midst of his distress, a radical act of faith emerges: *“But the Lord is with me, like a mighty warrior.”* Faith does not eliminate trials; it gives the strength to endure them with dignity.

This cry of Jeremiah echoes 600 years later in the words of Jesus, who, addressing the Twelve as he sent them on a mission to proclaim that “the Kingdom of Heaven has drawn near,” invites them—three times over—**not to be afraid**. Three times, **“Do not be afraid”**—why this insistence? These words follow another part of the discourse, in which Jesus foretells the difficulties Christians must expect: unjust trials, family troubles, hatred, slander—similar to those Jeremiah mentions in the first reading. Jesus does not downplay the risks. He does not say, “Everything will be fine.” He says, “Do not be afraid.”

Like Jesus, those who attempt it often encounter opposition and even hostility. But this Word also meets us in our everyday fears: fear of how others see us, fear of the future, fear of professing our faith publicly, fear of suffering or of being rejected.

This Sunday’s Gospel does not give us a formula for overcoming fear; it gives us a Presence: that of the Father who knows us, and of the Son who intercedes for us.

A question for the week: Is there a situation in my life where fear prevents me from bearing witness to my faith, defending the truth, or trusting in God? How do these texts call me to move forward despite everything?

Parish Information

Sacrament of Baptism (Infant): Our Baptisms are celebrated on the **fourth Sunday** of every month. Parents and godparents **are required** to attend **two (2)** preparation classes. Registration forms are available in the church office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 anytime for an anointing of the sick and dying. The priests visit our sick and shut-ins **every Friday with Holy Communion**.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm at the Shrine.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visit the sick **every Friday**. Please call the office if you have a sick or shut-in that you would like added to the list for home visits.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

The Sacrament of Matrimony: Please contact the priest **six (6) months** prior to the date of the intended wedding. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans. **Marriage preparation is mandatory.**

Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are encouraged to complete a parish registration form. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration helps in providing letters of request for proof of church membership. Also, if you have relocated or your mailing address or contact number has changed, please update it at the church office.

Church Cleaning: The church is cleaned every Friday of the Month at 6:30 p.m. Volunteers are needed and welcomed.

Catechesis

Two tendencies dwell in our hearts when faced with great evil: **vengeance and mercy.**

Vengeance tells us, *“Pay him back for what he did to you.”* Mercy tells us: *“Don’t let evil determine who you will become.”*

Retaliating with evil is often the first instinct of a wounded person. But Jesus reveals to us a higher path: that of love, which disarms hatred; of forgiveness, which breaks the cycle of violence; and of goodness, which refuses to be tainted by evil.

Vengeance is human. Mercy is divine. And both often dwell in our hearts. Every time we choose to forgive rather than seek revenge, to bless rather than curse, to extend a hand rather than a fist, it is God who grows within us. May mercy be stronger than our grudges, and may love always have the last word.

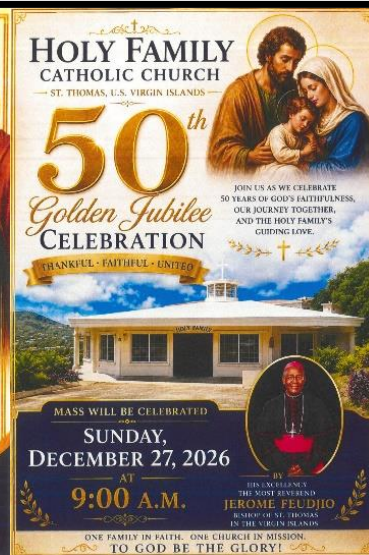
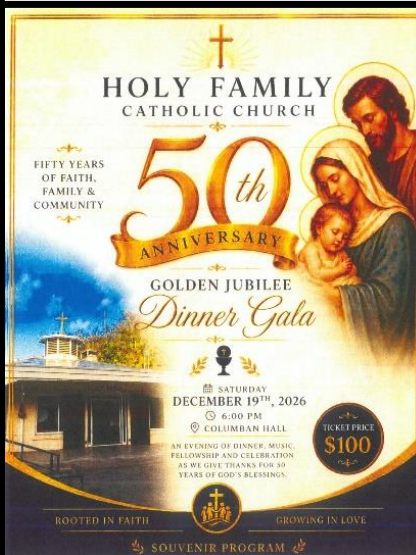

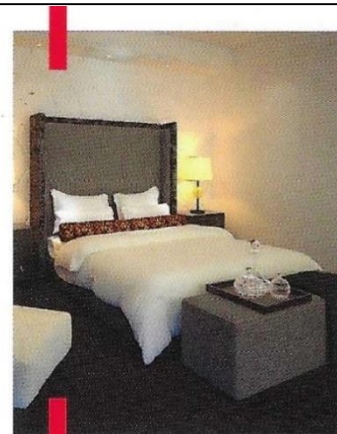
