WEEKLY REFLECTION

First Reading: Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14b-16a
Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 147:12-13, 14-15, 19-20

The Feast of Corpus Christi, or the Feast of the Body of Christ, is a feast that dates back to the 13th century. It developed to highlight devotion to the Holy Eucharist. It has sought to celebrate the very special presence of Jesus through the signs of bread and wine, which become the Body and Blood of Christ at every Mass. An incredible presence, a mysterious presence, accessible through faith in the Blessed Sacrament of the Body and Blood of Christ.

I know full well that all of us here are in complete agreement regarding the blessings of the Eucharist and are convinced that it is truly the real presence of Jesus. The Eucharist, as we know, is the source and summit of Christian life. It is both what gives us life and what we strive toward. The power of love goes beyond what we can see or feel. And the Lord knows that we need it. But he also knows that we are not always ready to receive it. Yet that does not prevent him from pouring out his graces and his love. From creatively connecting those who need bread for the journey to the source. And the bread in question is his own body, given for us.

Based on the Scripture readings we have heard, let us take a moment to allow ourselves to be filled with this mystery of the Eucharistic presence.

- In the first reading, the manna in the desert nourished the bodies of the Hebrew people on their journey to the Promised Land.
- In the Gospel (John 6:51-58), Jesus goes further: He declares, “I am the living bread that came down from heaven.” It is no longer merely food for survival; it is food for eternal life.

The Eucharist is not a treasure to be jealously guarded; it is a sacrament that transforms us.

- Saint Paul in the second reading reminds us: “Since there is one bread, we, though many, are one body.”
- By welcoming Christ into ourselves, we are called to become, in turn, shared bread for those who hunger for love, for a listening ear, for justice, and for hope in our world

Restored by the food God gives us, we carry Jesus in the hearts of all, he who involves everyone in the work of salvation, inviting each person to share in his table. Blessed are the guests who become witnesses to this love!

Sacrament of Baptism (Infant): Our Baptisms are celebrated on the **fourth Sunday** of every month. Parents and godparents **are required** to attend **two (2)** preparation classes. Registration forms are available in the church office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 anytime for an anointing of the sick and dying. The priests visit our sick and shut-ins **every Friday with Holy Communion**.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm at the Shrine.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visit the sick **every Friday**. Please call the office if you have a sick or shut-it that you would like added to the list for home visits.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

The Sacrament of Matrimony: Please contact the priest **six (6) months** prior to the date of the intended wedding. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans. **Marriage preparation is mandatory.**

Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are encouraged to complete a parish registration form. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration helps in providing letters of request for proof of church membership. Also, if you have relocated or your mailing address or contact number has changed, please update it at the church office.

Church Cleaning: The church is cleaned every Friday of the Month at 6:30 p.m. Volunteers are needed and welcomed.

Catechesis

Why is June the Month of the Sacred Heart?

Every year in June, Christians have celebrated the Sacred Heart since its establishment by Pope Pius IX (1792–1878) in the 19th century.

In popular piety, each month of the year has its own spiritual theme based on an aspect of the Christian faith. The month of June, for example, is the month of the Sacred Heart because its feast day is always celebrated in June, 19 days after Pentecost. This year, the Feast of the Sacred Heart will fall on Friday, June 12, 2022. It all began on the day Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647–1690) received revelations from Christ. On June 16, 1675, Jesus asked her to promote a spiritual movement in honor of His Sacred Heart.

“That is why I ask you that the first Friday after the octave of the Blessed Sacrament be dedicated to a special feast to honor my Heart, making reparation of honor through a penance, receiving Communion on that day to make amends for the indignities it has suffered while exposed on the altars; and I promise you that my Heart will expand to pour out in abundance the influences of its divine love upon those who render it this honor.”

Catholics have celebrated the Feast of Corpus Christi, the Feast of the Body of Christ, after Trinity Sunday for centuries. It always falls in the month of June. The exact date is determined each year based on the date of Easter. It was not until 1856 that the universal Church officially celebrated the Feast of the Sacred Heart for the first time. Since then, Christians have annually given thanks to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and his divine love for humanity.

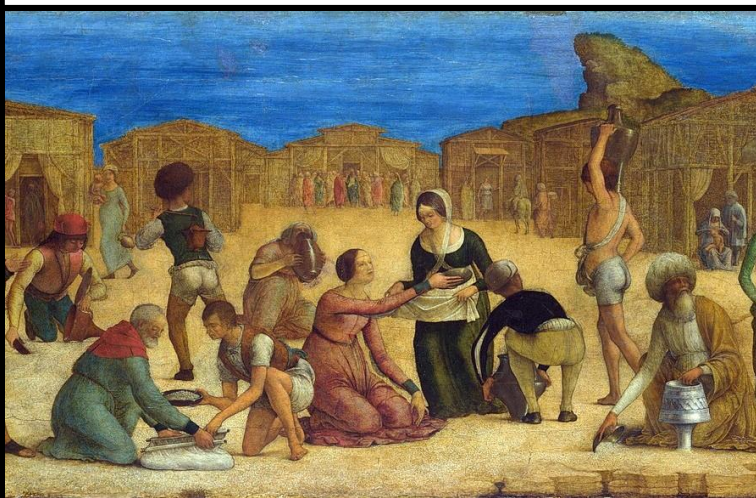

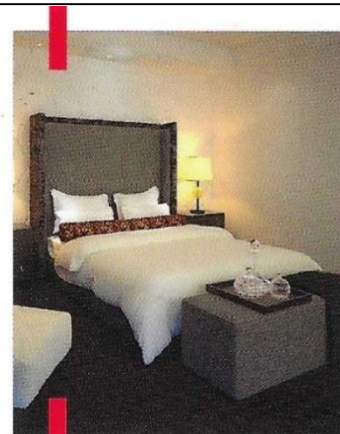


